# Magic Carpet Bed Runner 

Companion Pattern for Studio 180 Design's Four Patch Square Up ${ }^{\circledR}$, Tucker Trimmer ${ }^{\oplus}$ I, Split Rects ${ }^{\circledR}$, and Wing Clipper ${ }^{\oplus}$ I Tools


Time to use the rest of your units from Magic Carpet. Use these instructions to make a few more blocks and units to create a coordinating bed runner.

To finish the bed runner, you will need 2 yards of your background fabric, $1 / 4$ yard of Fabrics 9 and 10, and $1 / 8$ yard of Fabric 11.

It is recommended that you read through the instructions to familiarize yourself with the steps before you begin, and, of course, that you use your best skills when cutting, sewing, and pressing.

We'll start with a summary of the blocks you will need to create fo this project.

## Cutting Instructions

| Fabric | Piece | Cut |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Background | Uneven Chain | Cut 4 strips 21/4" x wof. |
|  |  | Cut 3 strips 51/4"x wof. |
|  | Setting Pieces | Cut 3 strips $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ wof; sub-cut into 40 rectangles $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. |
|  |  | Cut 3 strips $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ wof; sub-cut into: 4 rectangles $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 141 / 2$. 4 squares $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{1 / 2}$." |
|  | Star Block Finishing Pieces | Cut 2 strips $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x wof; sub-cut into 12 squares $4^{1} 12^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " and 3 squares $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ ". |
| Fabric 9 | Uneven Chain | Cut 2 strips 31/2" x wof. |
| Fabric 10 | Uneven Chain | Cut 3 strips 21/4"x wof. |
| Fabric 11 | Cornerstones | Cut 1 strip $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ wof; sub-cut into 10 squares $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. |

## Piecing Instructions

Step 1 - Star Blocks. Using the leftover combination units and flying geese, make 3 Star Blocks following steps 21-27 in your Magic Carpet pattern.
Step 2 - Uneven Chain Units. Follow steps 28-34 to make 24 L units.
Step 3 - Lay out the Uneven Chain Units, Background $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, and cornerstones to create the blocks shown here. Press toward the background rectangles.


Step 3 - Stitch and Press

Step 4 - Lay out the blocks, large squares, and rectangles following the diagram on page 2. Stitch together to create rows, then stitch the rows together to create the runner. Press the seams open to eliminate excess bulk.
