

# How to Install Double Sided Snaps Using a Table Press By: kimmysnabric.com

### **Materials Needed:**

- **KAM Table Press**
- Size 20 Snap Socket Dies
- **Double Sided Snap Base**
- Leather Hole Punch
- ♥ Size 20 socket snaps
- Double Sided Snaps
- ▼ The item you are putting a snap on.





Top piece for Socket





Base piece for Double Sided Snap







Set up your table press:


- The Double Sided Snap Die Base inserts into the bottom hole.
- Attach the socket diet by twisting it into the upper hole (for a DK93 press).





Punch holes where you wish the prong (sharp point) of the snap to be inserted.





**Crop-a-dile:** this tool has hole punch in 2 sizes

and attaches eyelets

Awl: Sharp and creates a small hole

Leather Hole Punch: can create 6 different sized

holes



### Applying the Double Sided Snap









Press the socket into the die, it should press into the die and be flat feeling.

Twist the die into the top of the table

press.

Insert the cap into the hole you made in the project you are adding the snap to.

The prong should stick out the back of your project.





Insert the stud with prong (double sided snap) and material into the press, make sure the stud sits evenly in the grooves of the press base die.



Press down on the handle the upper die should squash down on the material. You should see a slight bulge in the rubber of the die.

Remove from press.

# Make it Snap!

#### Front of Project




#### **Back of Project**



Notice the centers of the socket is equally pressed down. This means you have done well!
