In written lace stitch pattern: Row 19 is listed twice. The second row 19 should be row 23. The directions are correct, only the row number is wrong.

Page 75:

Shown in size 381/4" [97 cm] with 31/4" [8.5 cm] positive ease

At end of Left Front, pages 77-78:

Final row is Row 32 (32, 16, 16, 16, 16, 32, 32, 16) of lace panel.

Back, page 78, after final sleeve cast on:

Next row: Purl.

Tulip Fields Shawl

Rows 17-19 of chart are incorrect. Please work as follows:

Row 17: (RS) SI 1, k2, yo, ssk, k12, yo, ssk, k3 sts to end.

Row 18: SI 1, k21 sts to end.

Row 19: SI 1, k2, yo, ssk, k10, k2tog, yo, k5 sts to end.

Silverleaf Cardi

Page 82:

Right Front

Begin shoulder shaping

Next row: (WS) BO 6 (7, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 14, 16) sts, work to end –25 (26, 27, 28, 30, 32, 32, 33,

34) sts.

Work 1 RS row.

Next row: BO 7 (8, 9, 10, 12, 14, 14, 15, 16) sts, using the cable cast on to CO 1 st, work as est to end — 19 sts.

Right Collar

Cont in i-cord edging and lace panel as est, working sk2p at end of Row 7 as ssk, until collar meas 3" [9.5 cm] from last shoulder BO, end after a WS row. Break yarn, leaving a long tail for finishing, and place sts onto waste yarn or st holder.

Page 83:

Left Front

Begin shoulder shaping

Next row: (RS) BO 6 (7, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 14, 16) sts, work to end –25 (26, 27, 28, 30, 32, 32, 33,

34) sts.

Work 1 WS row.

Next row: Next row: BO 7 (8, 9, 10, 12, 14, 14, 15, 16) sts, using the cable cast on to CO 1 st, work as est to end -19 sts.

Left Collar

Cont in i-cord edging and lace panel as est, working SK2P at beg of Row 7 as k2tog, until collar meas 3" [9.5 cm] from last shoulder BO, end after a WS row. Break yarn, leaving a long tail for finishing, and place sts onto waste yarn or st holder.

Marigold Cardi

Page 86:

Begin 2X2 rib

First row: (WS) *P2, k2, rep from * to last 2 sts, p2. Next row: (RS) *K2, p2; rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Page 87:

Left Front

Continue garter st trim and begin armhole shaping

Next row: (WS) K5, purl to end.

Next row dec row: (RS) K1, ssk, knit to end (1 st dec'd)-58

(62, 66, 71, 75, 80, 84, 89, 93) sts rem.

Rep dec row every RS row 7 (8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 14, 16, 17) more times—51 (54, 57, 61, 64, 68, 70, 73, 76) sts rem.

Right Front

Return 59 (63, 67, 72, 76, 81, 85, 90, 94) held right front sts to circ and join yarn ready to work a WS row.

Continue garter st trim and begin armhole shaping

Next row: (WS) Purl to last 5 sts, k5.

Next row *dec row:* (RS) Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (1 st dec'd)—58 (62, 66, 71, 75, 80, 84, 89, 93) sts rem. Rep *dec row* every RS row 7 (8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 14, 16, 17) more times—51 (54, 57, 61, 64, 68, 70, 73, 76) sts rem.

Page 88:

Begin cap shaping

Short row 4: Purl to last wrapped st, pick up and purl wrap with its st, w&t.

Violet Bonnet

Page 91, to help clarify, the instructions have been re-written: Cont working even in Ripple Pattern with edges in garter st as est until Rows 1–12 have been worked a total of 4 (5) times.

Wildflowers Cap

Page 96:

Rows 6 and 18: Stitch 13, should be worked in MC.

Flower Fairy & Leaf Sprite

Page 98:

Continue center shaping, decreases

Next rnd dec rnd: K1, ssk, knit across Needle 1 to last 3 sts on Needle 2, k2tog, k1; on Needle 3, k1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 (4 sts dec'd)—
44 sts.

Next rnd: Knit

Rep last 2 rnds one time, then rep the *dec rnd* one more time—36 sts rem; 9 sts each on Needles 1 and 2, and 18 sts on Needle 3.
