

HOW TO USE:

1) CLEAN AND STERILIZE YOUR BAGS BEFORE FIRST USE.

To sterilize, you can boil the bags in hot water for 3 minutes. Please remove the plastic arms before boiling or steam sterilizing the bags. Strong detergents can leave an odor in silicone so we don't recommend putting them in the dishwasher. Wash bags with warm soapy water after each use; fragrance-free or mild dish soap is preferred.

2) ALLOW YOUR BAGS TO DRY COMPLETELY BEFORE USE.

For more convenient drying, the bags will stand upright when placed upside down (when the plastic arms are installed). The bags can also be hung to dry by their handles.

3) PUMP YOUR MILK INTO BOTTLES OR DIRECTLY INTO THE SILICONE BAGS (BAG ADAPTER SOLD SEPARATELY).

The measurement indicator on the bags is accurate when they are propped open. Please do not fill beyond 8 oz/240 ml. Use a dry erase marker or permanent marker to mark the amount, date, time, and/or name of your child.


4) SNAP THE CLASPS CLOSED AND STORE YOUR MILK IN THE FRIDGE OR FREEZER.





DISASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS*

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
1 Unlock the bag and then remove the mounting columns from the holes.
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
2 Bend the left arm and push the two arms in opposite directions (pull the left out and down while pushing the right arm forward). This will release the ball and socket joint.
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
3 Remove the unlocked arms from the silicone loop on the side of the bag and then repeat on the other side.
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
4 All done!


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

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1 Make sure the arrows on each arm are facing up.
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2 Insert the socket of one of the arms into the silicone loop on the side of the bag.
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3 Snap the ball of the second arm into the socket of the already assembled arm.
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4 Push the mounting columns into the holes in the center of the bag.
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5 Repeat ball and socket assembly on the other side.

*Quick disassembly trick: Unlock one of the clasps and then bend both arms in the direction of the remaining clasp that is still locked. This should pop the arms open on one side (at the ball and socket).
