

Important Information on The Care of Your Belt Drive System

With the goal of low maintenance and reliable performance, here is important tip to help prolong the life of your Priority belt drive system.

During normal operation, it is possible that dust and fine road debris can build up on the surface of your sprockets causing them to act like an abrasive on the belt surface that can prematurely wear it down. This is usually more evident on the smaller rear sprocket.

Check out your rear sprocket and belt for any excessive or premature wear (see highlighted diagram below).

Here are some recommended tips to prolong the life of all components:

- Check the surface of the belt and sprockets from time to time to ensure they are clean and free of any compacted materials.
- Clean with a fine stiff brush, or an old toothbrush, and water as the best way to remove any foreign materials (do not use solvents).
- Allow to dry before using your bike.
