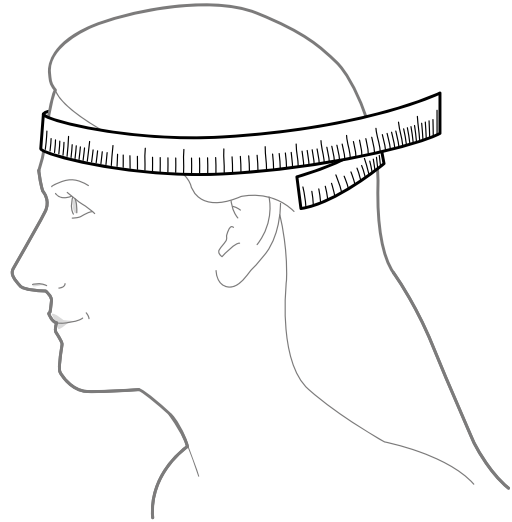


# HOW TO CHOOSE YOUR HELMET SIZE

- 1 Use a measuring tape to measure around your head one inch above your eyebrows. Or use a string to measure and then lay it out and measure the length of the string.



- 2 Use this chart to convert measurement to hat size:

HEAD SIZE (inches)	20 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub>	20 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub>	21 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub>	21 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub>	22	22 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub>	23 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>8</sub>	23 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub>	24	24 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub>
HEAD SIZE (cm)	52	53	54	55	56	57	59	60	61	62
HAT SIZE	6 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub>	6 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub>	6 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub>	6 <sup>7</sup> / <sub>8</sub>	7	7 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>8</sub>	7 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>8</sub>	7 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>2</sub>	7 <sup>5</sup> / <sub>8</sub>	7 <sup>3</sup> / <sub>4</sub>
