

## Introduction

Big Book of Bible Activities, Songs, and Rhymes for Early Childhood is designed to make each lesson more fun and interactive for children ages 3–6! With 66 songs, 30 rhymes, and 102 teaching ideas, this book is a great tool for teachers! Each page in this book includes a Scripture reference and Bible story title to help you identify which Bible story the song, rhyme, or idea correlates to (also available in the table of contents). These songs, rhymes, and ideas will keep your kids singing, moving, and actively learning each time they come to class and will help them remember the Bible stories long after they've gone home!

#### **Bible Songs**

The Bible songs are piggyback songs written to familiar tunes. Music scores are included in the back of the book for tunes that may be unfamiliar to you.

#### **Action Rhymes**

Children learn quickly when they can move and interact with the stories they're learning! The action rhymes in this book include motions that you can do with the children in your class as you learn the rhymes. Practice the motions before class so that you can comfortably lead them as you teach.

#### **Teaching Ideas**

Each song and rhyme includes a correlating, creative teaching idea. These ideas offer fun ways to teach the song or rhyme or ways to reinforce the Bible story with the children you teach. Each teaching idea includes a list of supplies you'll need as well as detailed directions. When a craft

is involved, examples are shown to help you understand what the activity will look like when it is completed.

### Activity Options for Younger Children

These options were designed to help make activities easier for children at the younger range of the early-childhood age level. Adapt the teaching ideas to the age you teach.

#### **Helps**

The table of contents is arranged canonically by Scripture references for your convenience. Each listing also tells you if what's listed is a song, rhyme, or teaching idea so that you can find what you're looking for quickly and easily!

The index on pages 218–222 will help you find specific songs, rhymes, and ideas in alphabetical order within each of these three categories.

If you're using HeartShaper Children's Curriculum, you'll want to check out the Scope and Sequence on pages 223–224 to find songs, rhymes, and ideas that correlate to your lesson each week.

#### **God Made**



God Made the Sky and Earth; God Made Fish and Birds; God Made Animals; God Made People

Genesis 1

Tune: "Jesus Loves Me"

God made daytime and night too. God made sunlight and the moon. God made all the stars at night. See them twinkle, oh so bright.

#### Chorus:

God made them all. God made them all. God made them all. Yes, God made them all.

God made mountains and the hills. God made grass and daffodils. God made tasty food to eat veggies green and fruit that's sweet.

#### Repeat chorus

God made bugs and God made birds. God made fish and cattle herds. God made every animal some are big and some are small.

#### Repeat chorus

God made dads and mommies too, brothers, sisters—even you.
Grandmas, Grandpas we can love.
All these blessings from above.

Song suggestion: Because this song contains several verses, consider teaching it to the children over the course of several weeks. Teach one verse each week until the entire song is learned. Sing the song slowly at first while the children are learning the words and then speed up the song as you like once you feel the children can keep up. Adding motions will help kids remember the verses, and the added energy will help keep kids engaged!



## Creation Sensory Bottles

God Made the Sky and Earth; God Made Fish and Birds; God Made Animals; God Made People Genesis 1

Use these Creation Sensory Bottles to help children visualize what God made on each day of creation.

Allow kids to make individual Creation Sensory Bottles or use 2-liter bottles and place them in a learning center for the children to share. Kids can peer at the items through the plastic bottles or shake the bottles to see the items move inside.

#### Supplies

- small, clear plastic bottles with caps (2-liter bottles to use in a learning center; 3 per child)
- water
- duct tape
- black permanent marker
- glue

#### Additional Supplies for Days 1–4 of Creation

- 1 large piece of black fabric
- 1 large piece of white fabric
- small pebbles (5 per child or enough to cover the bottom of each bottle)
- small silk flowers (3–5 per child)

#### Directions for Days 1-4 of Creation

Before class cut the black and white fabric into strips. Each strip should be 3" long and  $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide. Cut enough for each child to have one black strip and one white strip.

Give each child one clear, plastic bottle. Have the children place the black and white fabric into their bottles as you talk about God making light and dark. Talk about God making the earth and water as the children add pebbles and water to their bottles. Do not fill the bottles completely—leave room to add the flowers. Talk about God making plants as the children add the silk flowers to their bottles. Secure the caps on each bottle using duct tape. Label each bottle with the child's name.

#### **Additional Supplies for Day 5 of Creation**

- colorful craft feathers (2 or 3 per child)
- small fish cut from craft foam (3–5 per child)

#### **Directions for Day 5 of Creation**

Before class cut out fish from the craft foam that are small enough to fit through the opening of a bottle.







Give each child a new bottle. Have the children place several feathers into their bottles. Talk about God making the birds. When you talk about God making the fish, have the children place the foam fish in their bottles. Finish by adding water to the bottles and securing the caps with duct tape

#### **Additional Supplies for Day 6 of Creation**

• small plastic or foam animals (4 per child)

#### **Directions for Day 6 of Creation**

Give each child a new bottle. Have the children place the small plastic or foam animals into their bottles. Talk about God making all of the different kinds of animals. Secure the caps with duct tape.

#### Cake Pan Creation

God Made the Sky and Earth; God Made Fish and Birds; God Made Animals; God Made a World for People

Genesis 1

Have fun making this creation scene with children as you talk about what God made.

#### **Supplies**

- 9" x 13" cake pan
- · small bag of potting soil
- 3 small houseplants
- 1 cup of water
- 3 or more small, plastic animals

#### **Directions**

Ask the children what God created when He made the world. As children respond, begin placing the items listed into the cake pan. First place soil into the pan. Next, add several small houseplants to the soil. Add the water, distributing it evenly around the soil. Finally, place several small, plastic animals in the pan to complete the creation scene.

As you move through this activity, explain to the children that God made the world and prepared a special place where people can live. Consider asking children to tell about their favorite things that God made.

Close with a prayer, thanking God for making a wonderful world for people.

Genesis 1-2

#### God made Adam and Eve his wife.

(raise pointer finger of right hand for Adam then add middle finger for Eve)

#### **God formed their bodies**

(pat arms)

#### and gave them life.

(cup hands at mouth and blow puff of air)

#### God gave them legs and feet to walk,

(point to legs; march in place)

#### eyes to see, and mouths to talk.

(point to eyes then to mouth)

#### They used their arms to carry things

(flex muscles twice as though lifting weights)

#### Their ears could hear the bluebirds sing.

(cup hand at ear as though straining to hear something)

#### God loved the people He made back then.

(cross arms over chest)

#### He loves us too; He is our friend.

(nod head yes)











#### Stick People Puppets

#### God Made People; God Made Adam and Eve

Genesis 1-2: Proverbs 20

#### **Supplies**

- assorted pictures of people's heads cut from magazines or taken from the Internet (each about the size of a nickel)
- scissors
- wooden craft sticks (1 per child)
- tape

Encourage the children to put on a puppet show using their Stick People Puppets.

Say a prayer, thanking God for all of the children in the class and for making each person special.

#### **Directions**

Before class cut several pictures of people's heads from old magazines or from pictures taken from the Internet. Kids will attach these to wooden craft sticks to make stick puppets. Each head should be approximately the size of a nickel. Prepare enough for each child to have at least one puppet.

During class assist children in taping precut pictures of people's heads to the ends of craft sticks.

Talk with children about how the people they chose look different from the others that were chosen by the other children. Talk with children about the similarities and differences between people and about how God made each person unique and special.
