Introduction






So Many Animals

God made the animals of the sea and sky and earth. To find out what God thought of all He had done, write the first letter of each animal in the box next to it.




God Makes People

God made human beings. To find out how God made us, color all the boxes with only ONE dot inside.






Obeying God




Abraham Lets Lot Choose First
