Introduction

This book contains 127 Bible puzzles that help you teach important Bible facts and principles. Each puzzle

- contains a Scripture reference and a Bible-story topic for easy reference (Bible memory puzzles include only a reference),
- is able to be photocopied, for use many times with many different students,
- is a complete activity, with no extra materials besides pencils, crayons, and markers required,
- reinforces and teaches Bible lessons,
- correlates with a Scripture from Standard Publishing's HeartShaper® Early Elementary curriculum, and
- contains a separate answer key on pages 135-142.

How to Find the Puzzles You Want

To find a puzzle based on a particular Scripture, look in the Table of Contents on pages 3-6. The first 104 puzzles are based on Bible stories or Bible passages. The Old Testament puzzles are arranged in order of the books of the Bible from Genesis through Jonah. The New Testament puzzles are arranged in chronological order. The last 23 puzzles are based on Bible memory verses, and are also arranged in order through the Bible.

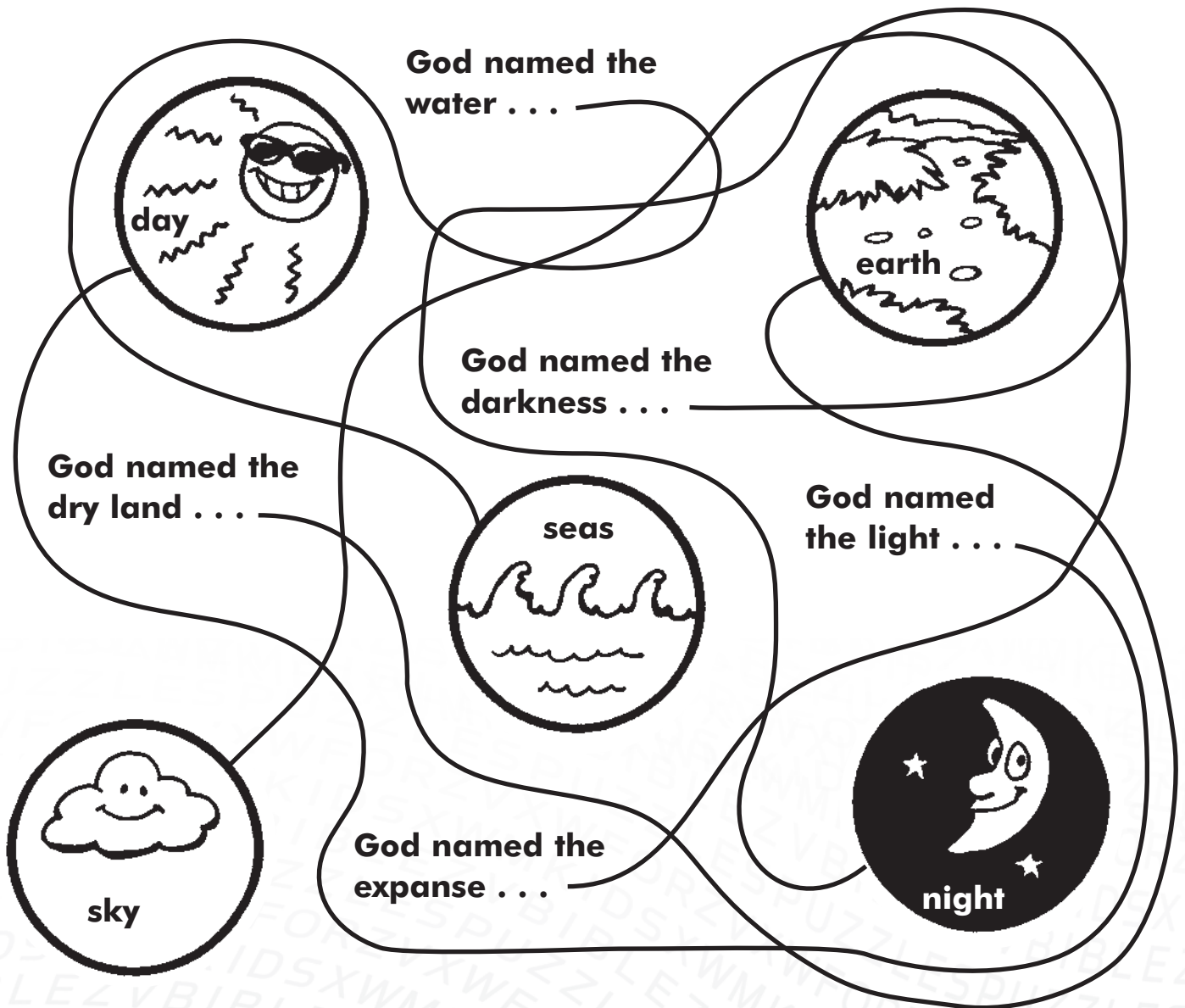

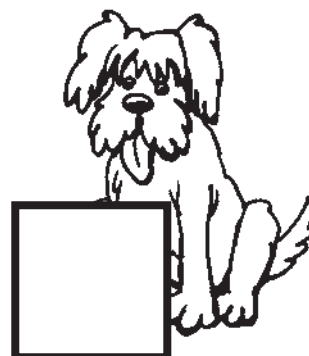
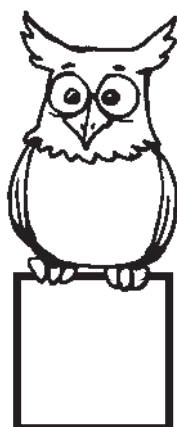
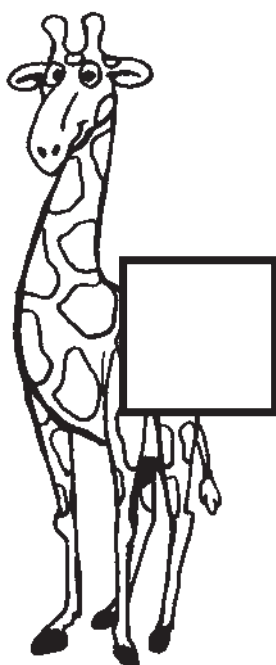
Everything from Nothing

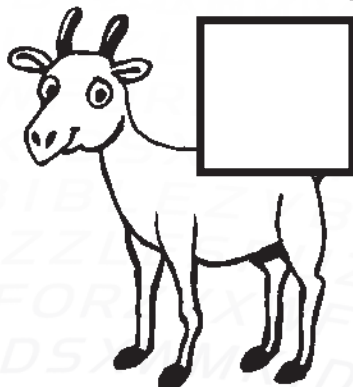
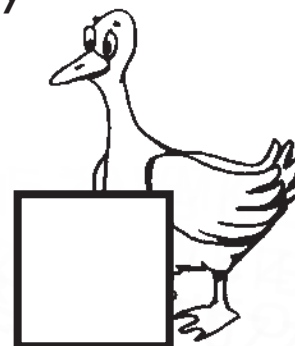
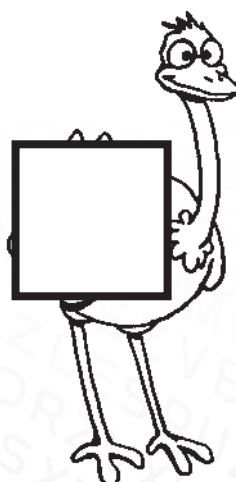
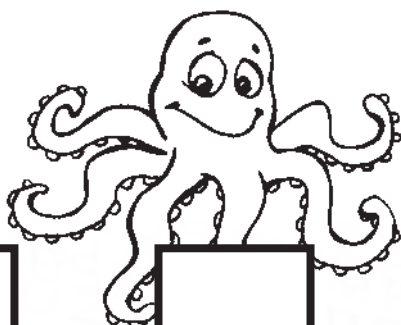


So Many Animals

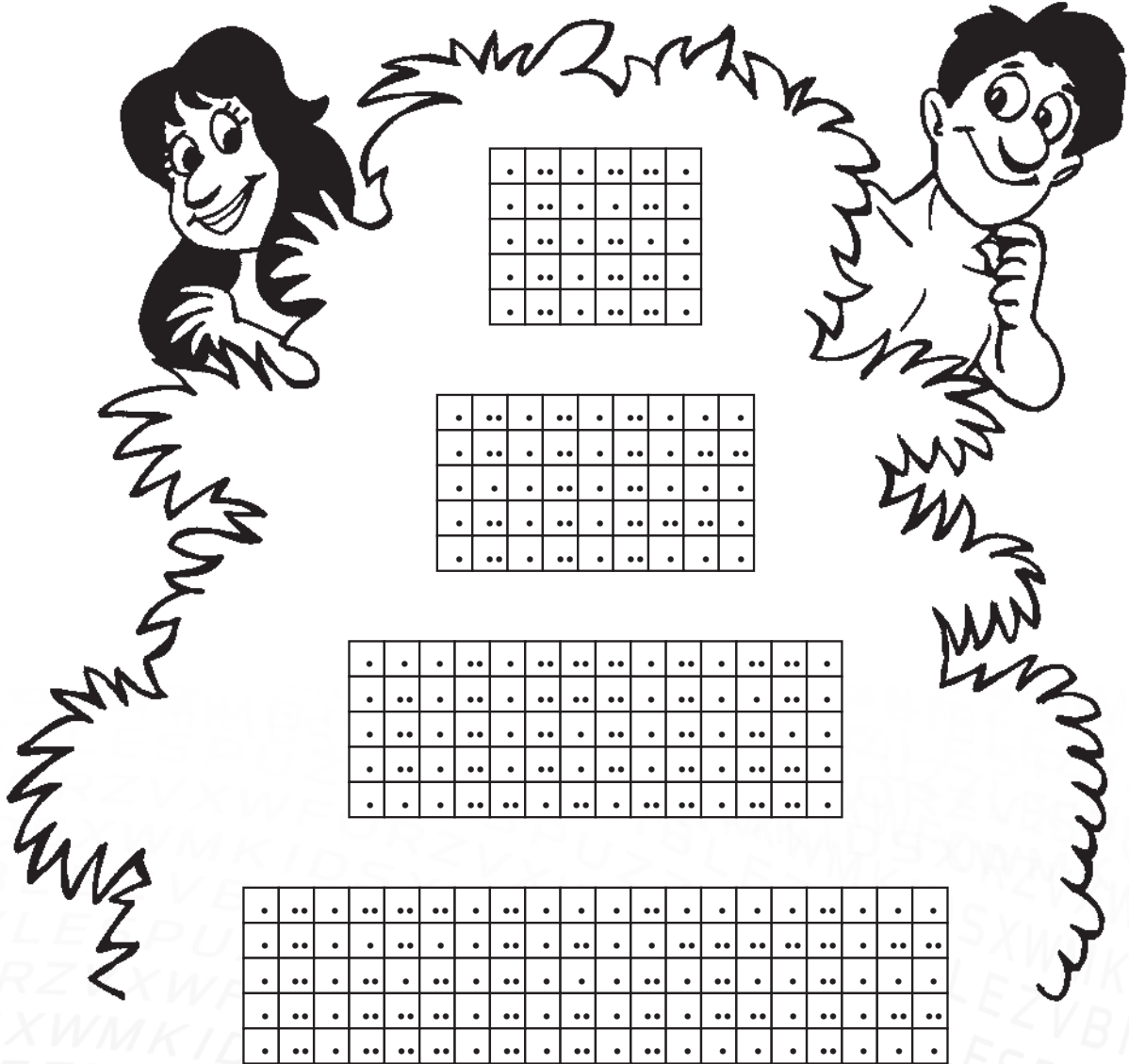

God Made Us

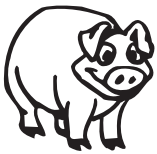
God made human beings. To find out how God made us, color all the boxes with only ONE dot inside.

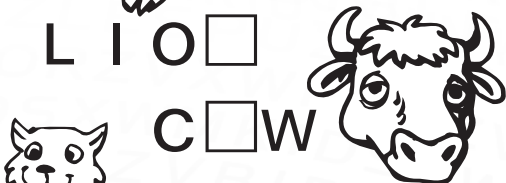
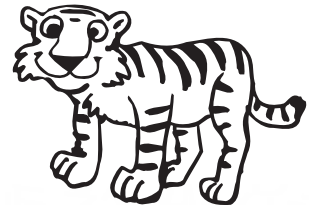

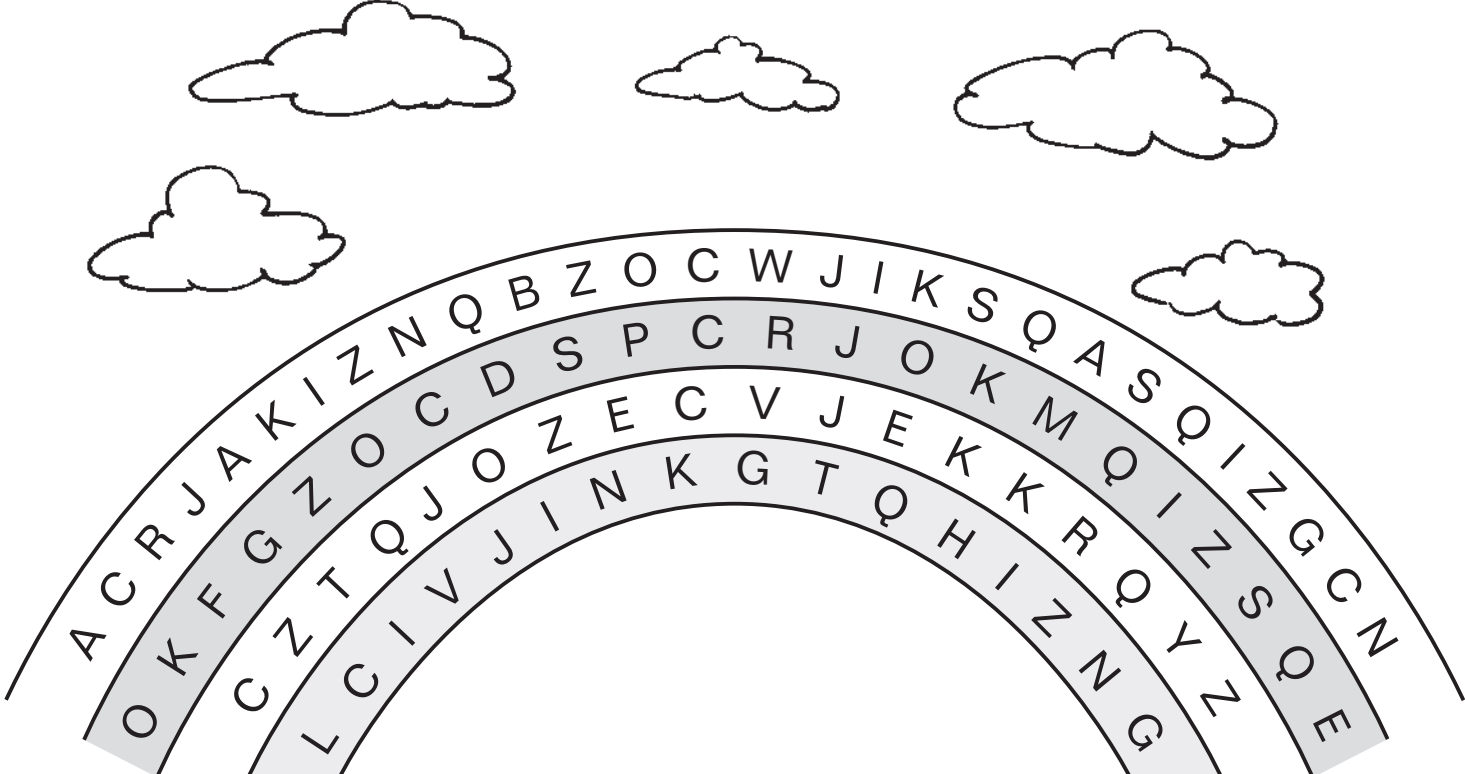

Cross out the letters C, J, K, Q, and Z every time you see them in the puzzle. Copy the leftover letters in each row to create a sentence about God's special sign.



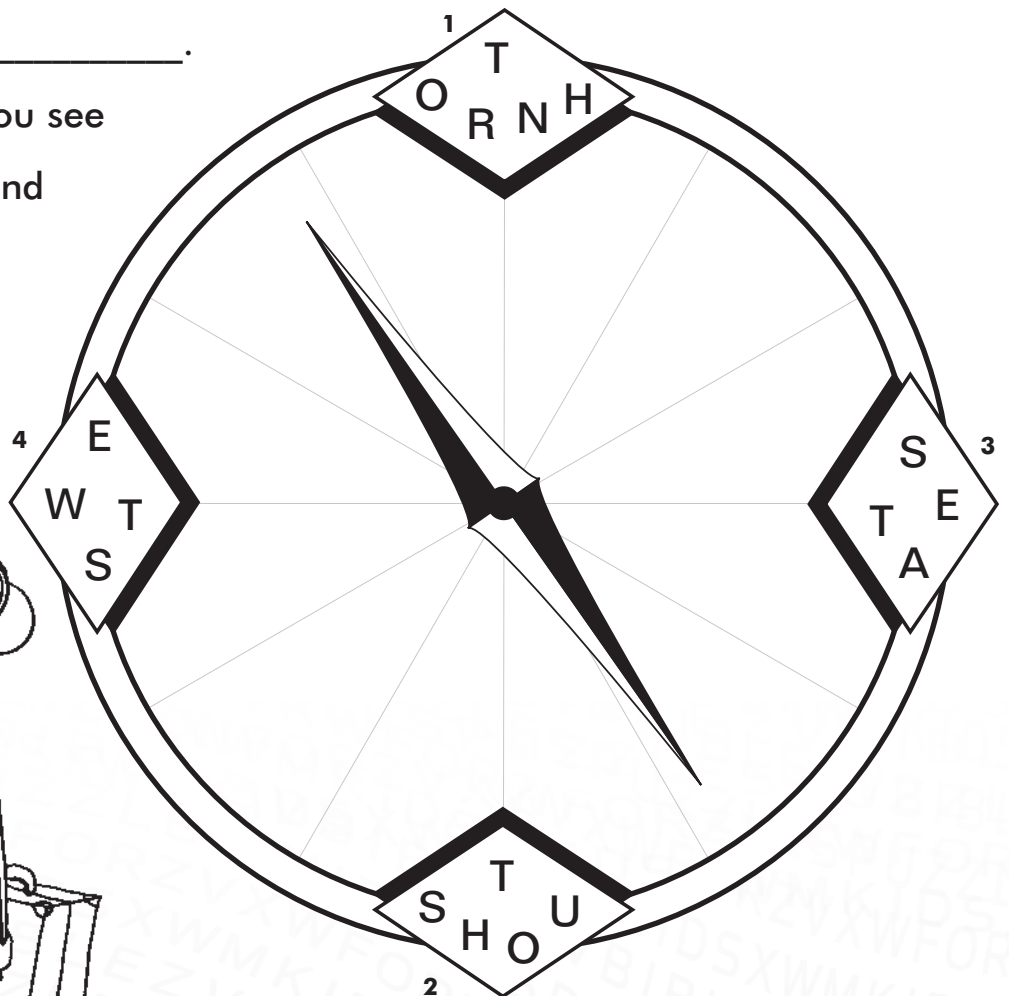

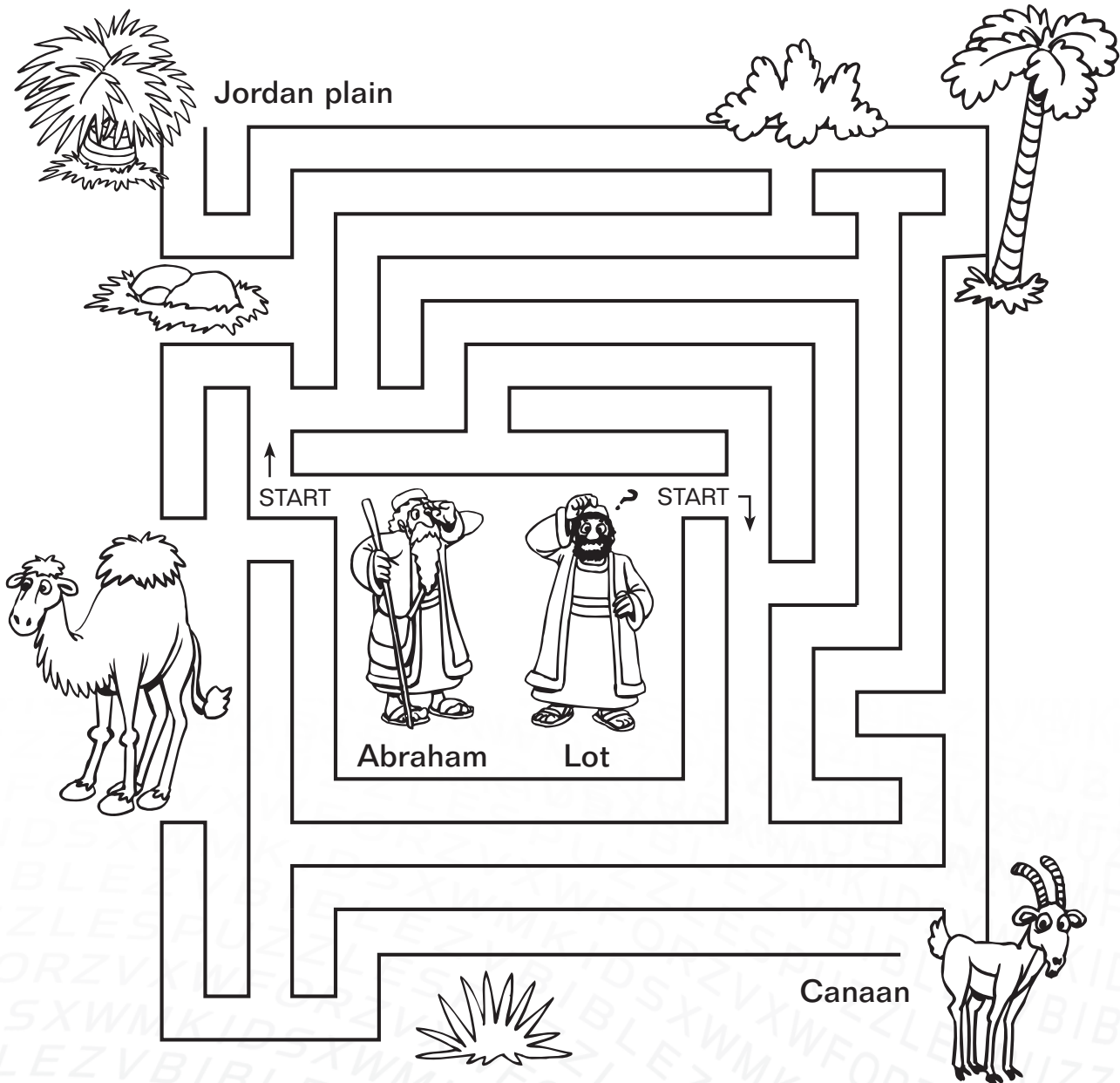
Abraham Lets Lot Choose First
