## Great Ways to Use These Pages:

- 🌱 Use the photocopied pages as rewards for children who memorize the Bible verse. They may take the page home to color and display.
- 🌱 Photocopy a set of coloring posters for each student. Cover with a folded sheet of construction paper and staple to make individual coloring books.
- 🌱 Use the pages in class for children who arrive early, transition times or students who finish an activity ahead of other students.
- 🌱 Play a coloring game. Place a variety of felt pens on the table. Recite the verse together. Then each student may choose a pen and use it to color on his or her page for one minute. When time is up, students put pens down and repeat verse together again. Students then choose another pen and color for one minute. Repeat process until pages are completed or students tire of activity.
- 🌱 To customize pages, cover the Bible verse with white paper and letter another verse or saying in its place before you photocopy.
- 🌱 Use pages to reinforce daily or weekly Bible memory verse.
- 🌱 Make your own Bible memory verse puzzle. Paste coloring page onto poster board and cut into jigsaw puzzle pieces. Place puzzle pieces in a resealable sandwich bag and label.
- 🌱 Give to your own children as a great substitute for secular coloring books.
