### 4. FIRST AID MEASURES

**General notes**

Do not induce vomiting and seek medical attention immediately. Drink two glasses of water or milk to dilute. Provide medical care provider with this MSDS. Induce vomiting as a last measure. Induced vomiting may lead to aspiration of the material into the lungs potentially causing chemical pneumonitis.

**5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES**

**SUITABLE EXTINGUISHING MEDIA:** Carbon Dioxide, Dry Chemical, Foam, or other NON-Aqueous material.
