

### Locked Floats

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# Purling (locking MC)



1. Wrap MC clockwise up over RH needle (opposite way from purling)



2. Bring CC around needle as if to purl (counter clockwise)



3. Hold onto CC while removing MC yarn off of needle



4. Complete stitch.

## Purling (locking CC)

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1. Insert RH needle into stitch to be worked. Move CC up over RH needle and between stitches. Keep tension on CC yarn



2. Wrap MC counter clockwise to purl



3. Bring CC back down below stitch, and complete purl.



4. Trapped stitches are completed after working next stitch.

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## Knitting (locking MC)



1. Insert needle into stitch



2. Wrap MC (in right hand) over CC onto RH needle and wrap counter clockwise



3. Wrap CC same direction (as if to knit) but wait to complete stitch



4. Move MC clockwise off of needle, and to back of work. Complete stitch





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# Knitting (locking CC)



1. Insert needle into stitch. Move RH needle under CC (and keep tension on yarn)



2. Wrap MC over RH needle as if to knit



3. Return CC yarn to back of work, and complete stitch
