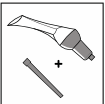
The Vintorio Wine Aerator Pourer

A crucial and often ignored step in fully enjoying wine is letting the wine breathe, or exposing the wine to oxygen by allowing it to aerate before you drink it. Unfortunately, proper aeration can sometimes take up to two hours through traditional methods.

That's where Vintorio comes in! The patented Vintorio Wine Aerator Pourer effectively and instantly brings the best out of your wine in less than 30 seconds! With the Vintorio Wine Aerator Pourer, you can dramatically improve your wine's aroma and flavor as you pour.



QUICK START



How to Use Your Aerator Pourer

- 1** Gently connect the air tube to the main pourer unit. Little to no force should be applied when connecting these two parts as the air tube may break if put under significant pressure.
- 2** Insert the Vintorio Wine Aerator Pourer into your bottle of wine with the pouring end pointing upwards. For easy insertion, wipe the rubber gasket with a damp piece of cloth before inserting the Vintorio Aerator Pourer into the bottle.
- 3** Pour your wine and listen for the bubbling sounds that are made as the wine flows through the aerator. This indicates your wine is being thoroughly aerated.
- 4** Enjoy your glass of perfectly aerated wine.





How to Clean



- Hand wash before use. Please do not use abrasive materials as this will result in scratching of the plastic/acrylic material.
- The Vintorio Wine Aerator Pourer can be easily cleaned by rinsing in warm water right away after use.
- For a more thorough cleanse, the Vintorio Wine Aerator can be disassembled.

Disassembly

1. Disconnect the air tube from the main pourer unit.
2. Hold the black plastic flow regulator unit in place and twist the clear acrylic pour spout counterclockwise.
3. Once you feel a slight resistance, take the two units apart.

** Do not use force to twist or take the two units apart.*



Reassembly

1. Make sure that the clear spout is pointing down (with the Vintorio Logo facing up) and the three air holes on the black plastic flow regulator unit are also facing up.

** The clear acrylic piece and the black flow regulator unit will not create a leak-free seal if this is not done properly.*

2. Align the rectangular nodes on the bottom end of the clear acrylic spout with the grooves on the top opening of the black flow regulator and put the two units together.

3. Hold the black plastic flow regulator unit in place and twist the clear acrylic pour spout clockwise to fasten the two units.

4. Connect the air tube to the main pourer unit and your Vintorio Wine Aerator Pourer is ready to be used.



Make sure that the arrow is in the lock position when reassembling to prevent any potential leaking

Tips for the Vintorio Wine Aerator

To use your aerator like a pro, try tasting your wine right after you open the bottle, 10 minutes, and 30 minutes after opening the bottle. You will notice that your wine tastes different every time. Now you know when your favorite wine tastes best.

If the rubber gasket of your aerator “scrunches up” or if you have a hard time inserting your aerator into your bottle, it is because the rubber gasket may have been stored in a dry area. To resolve this issue, simply wipe the rubber gasket with a damp piece of cloth and try again.

Do not use force to twist or take apart your aerator. Although we used sturdy quality materials to make our aerators, they can break if put under significant pressure. Treat your aerator like you would treat your wine.



Issues With Your Aerator? No Problem!

❶ My aerator broke and won't stay together!

We find that most people break their aerators because they did not follow the assembly/disassembly instructions properly. Here are some key points that should prevent your aerator from breaking!

- Do not try to “pop” or force the two pieces back together. As long as you do not use excessive force on your aerator, it should not break.
- Make sure that the Vintorio logo on the clear spout and the three air holes on the black plastic flow regulator unit are facing the same direction during assembly. It is not meant to be assembled any other way.
- If you break your aerator, let us know and we will fix or replace it.



Issues With Your Aerator? No Problem!

② My aerator is leaking! How can I make it stop?

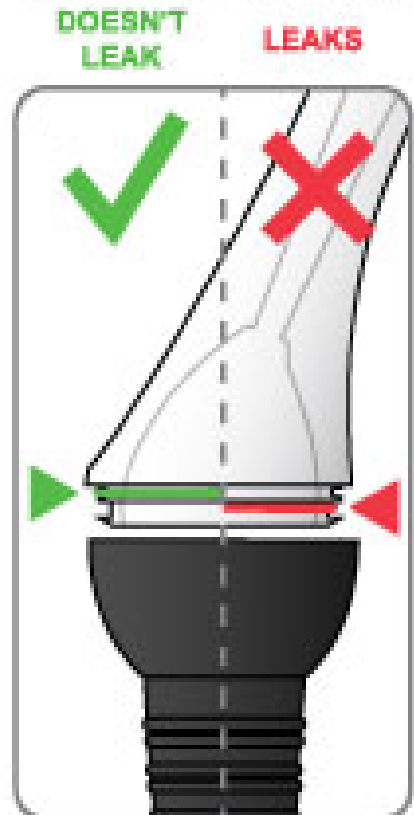
A leak in the Vintorio Aerator Pourer means that there is something wrong with the seal between the clear spout and black plastic flow regulator. The seam between the two units is usually very tight because it is sealed with an “O” shaped clear rubber ring and will not leak unless there is something wrong with the ring.

There are 2 key points to remember:

- Make sure that the Vintorio Logo and the three air holes are facing the same direction. Some users assemble the Vintorio Aerator UPSIDE DOWN, this will not create a leak-free seal and will cause wine to leak out of the air holes when pouring.
- Make sure the clear rubber washer on the bottom on the clear spout is not lost/missing or in the wrong position. The clear rubber washer is glued on to the spout but may sometimes get lost during cleaning. Contact us if you lose your clear rubber washer.

Directions To Prevent Leaks

Place the clear rubber ring in the correct groove shown in green below to prevent the aerator from leaking



There is a clear, rubber o-ring sealed onto the bottom of the spout that may not be obvious at first glance. If it is missing, the aerator may start leaking.

Frequently Asked Questions

Does this aerator work on white wines as well?

Yes, the Vintorio Wine Aerating Pourer can be effectively used for red and white wines.

What is the aerator made out of?

The Vintorio Wine Aerating Pourer is made of FDA-approved, BPA-free, high-quality acrylic and sturdy ABS plastic. All of our products adhere to strict quality check standards.

Is it dishwasher-safe?

Yes, but we recommend cleaning the Vintorio Wine Aerating Pourer by simply disassembling the units and running it under warm water.

What are the dimensions of the clear o-ring?

The clear o-ring dimensions are 25 mm (outer) and 22 mm (inner).

Frequently Asked Questions

My Vintorio Aerator is leaking at the seam, what do I do?

If wine leaks from the seal between the acrylic spout and black flow regulator; that means that is something wrong with the clear rubber washer ring that is located on the spout. Check to see if the rubber washer is stretched or broken and if the leaking persists, let us know.

Can I get a replacement stem? I accidentally lost mine.
