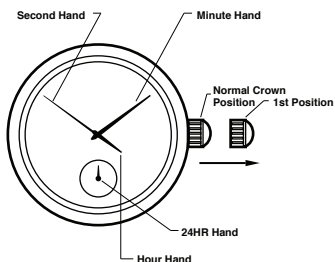

## DISPLAY AND BUTTONS



## SETTING THE TIME

1. Pull the crown out to the 1st position to stop the second hand at 0 (12 o'clock).
2. Turn the hour/minute hands in a clockwise direction to set the time.
3. To ensure time is set accurately, first turn the minute hand 5 minutes ahead of desired time and then turn back (in a counterclockwise) to the desired time.
4. After setting the time, use a time signal to synchronize the watch by pushing crown to the normal position to start the second hand going.

### NOTE:

Make sure you have correctly set AM/PM before setting the time.

**ATTENTION:** For watches with a screwdown crown, unscrew to set time and when finished screw back crown fully to avoid water entering the module. Crown covers should only be rotated 90 degrees clock-wise to access the crown.

## CAUTION

1. Do not touch internal components other than the batteries.
2. Keep your watch in a cool dry place.
3. Avoid abrasions as scratching may eventually affect the case and bracelet.

## BATTERY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Mixed usage of a different type of battery or use of new and used battery is not recommended.
2. Battery should be inserted with correct polarity.
3. Supply terminals should not be short-circuited.
