


CHRONOGRAPH JS15

## DISPLAY AND BUTTONS



## SETTING THE TIME AND 24-HOUR

- 1. Pull the crown out to the 2nd position.
  - 2. Turn the crown clockwise to set hour, minute and 24-hour hands to the desired time.
- 3. Push the crown back to the normal position.

## SET THE SECOND TIME ZONE

- 1. Set the crown at the normal position.
- 2. Press Button B step-by-step to advance the hand of the second time zone by one hour per step until the desired time is set.

# SETTING THE DATE

- Pull the crown out to the 1st position.
- 2. Turn the crown clockwise. The date will advance 1 day when the time reaches 00:00 midnight. Continue to turn the crown until the desired date is set
- 3. Push the crown back to the normal position.

#### Quick Correction of Date:

- 1. Pull the crown out to the 1st position.
- Turn the crown clockwise step-by-step to the desired date.
  Push the crown back to the normal position.

ATTENTION: Please do not set if between 21:00 and 00:30 midnight.

## CHRONOGRAPH FUNCTION

- 1. To start the chronograph press Button A
- 2. To stop the chronograph press Button A again.
- To reset the chronograph press Button B.
- \*Note: Chronograph runs a maximum of 1 hour.

#### CHRONOGRAPH ALIGNMENT

- 1. Pull crown out to 2nd position and press Button A until chronograph second hand is at 12 o'clock.
- 2. Push crown back to normal position.

#### CAUTION

- 1. Do not touch internal components other than the batteries.
- 2. Keep your watch in a cool dry place.
- 3. Avoid abrasions as scratching may eventually affect the case and bracelet.

#### BATTERY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Mixed usage of a different type of battery or use of new and used battery is not recommended.
- 2. Battery should be inserted with correct polarity.
- 3. Supply terminals should not be short-circuited.
