- Build and maintain technical specifications, ie. BOM, construction, measurements, print & pattern, packaging, trim, and associated technical images.
- Build and maintain tech packs that accurately translate apparel construction, color, fit, and details
- Work with manufacturing partners throughout the development process
- Build and maintain size specification and grade sheets from concept prototypes through final fit approval.
- Must be detail oriented and show ability to work in a face-paced, deadline driven environment.
- Track and monitor progress of fit samples, size set samples and pre-production samples in relation to deadlines.
- Assigns appropriate grading to all points of measure, keeping the proportion accurate in relation to our predetermined sizing.
- Evaluate and provide feedback on swatches, lab dips, strike-offs, trim and detail samples, fit samples, size set samples and pre-production samples for fit, measurement and construction accuracy and quality.

- Provide feedback and revisions clearly to manufacturing partners in a timely fashion.
- Ensure overall fit consistency and provide fit approvals when necessary.
