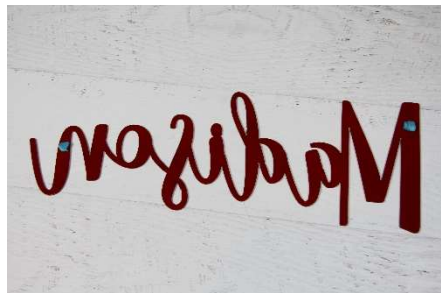
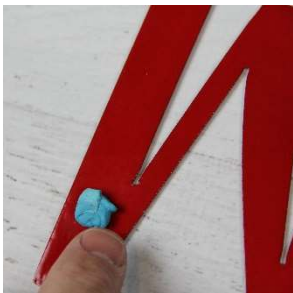

Thank you for purchasing our beautiful hand crafted and custom designed metal art from Madison Iron and Wood. Now that you have your beautiful decorative piece you are wondering, "How do I hang it?" Here is just 3 suggestions that we have for hanging your creative masterpiece.

1. My first and favorite is using mounting putty. I typically use Loctite® brand mounting tabs. This is best for a flawless front facing finish. I don't have a secret for the amount to use. For a small piece of metal art two small pieces is enough, for larger pieces use more 😊. I do stock these for convenience, but they are available in most hardware stores.



2. Use a small brad nail under small loops in the letters or other geometry in the piece. From just a little distance you would never notice the brad nail at all. I would suggest using a dark coated brad so it is less visible. Just like the mounting putty, the heavier the piece the more nails you should use.



3. The final one is to drill a hole and apply a mounting screw or nail. In some cases on custom metal art I will have the hole pre-set and supply a powder coated phillips head screw for mounting.
