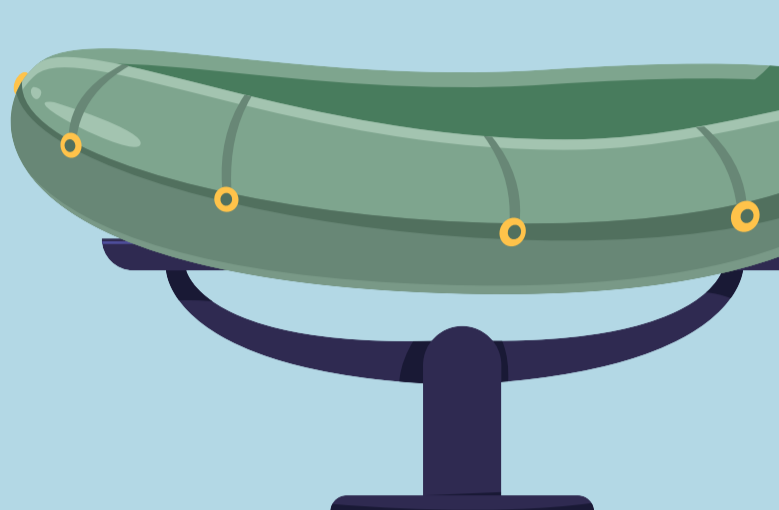
Do They Live Up to the Hype?

Affordable

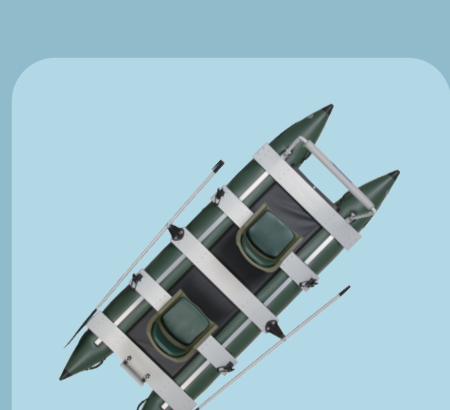

Long Lifespan

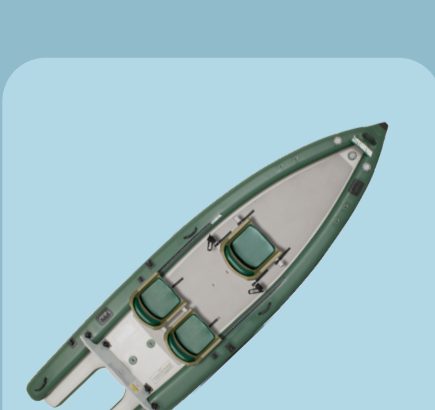
