There are different kinds of materials used to construct high quality inflatable fishing kayaks, such as PVC, Nitrylon, and Hypalon. There are advantages to each (PVC is the most economical, Nitrylon is stronger but heavier.) but Hypalon is the most durable and reliable and is used by the US Coast Guard and militaries across the world.

Are you looking for a 1 person fishing kayak or are you more interested in a 2 or 3 person fishing kayak? Whether you want a high quality solo fishing kayak or high quality tandem fishing kayak, there is one to meet your needs. Solo fishing kayaks can be easier for beginners to learn their way, but tandem versions offer advantages as well.

Accessories are one of the next areas to look at on your quest to find the best inflatable fishing kayaks. Some inflatable kayaks will come with built in features such as a ruler printed on a side wall for easy use. Some of these can be huge pluses and can make your kayak fishing experience more enjoyable. The Best Inflatable Fishing Kayak Reviews

1.) Sea Eagle 385fta FastTrack Angler Inflatable Kayak



The <u>Sea Eagle 385fta Fishing Kayak</u> is one of the overall best inflatable fishing kayaks and it really shows it's advantage in tougher outdoor climates and waters. It has a range of innovative features created by anglers, for anglers. Everything from non-slip flooring, to a dynamically designed stern and bow, to rod and paddle holders are included.

It also has a range of storage options built into the spray skirts, so that you can hold all of your tools, lures, and supplies. The cherry on top is that it is also extremely comfortable. The fishing kayak can be setup as a solo or tandem fishing kayak, and can even seat three people plus equipment and can be purchased with a deluxe or swivel seat rig package.

The Sea Eagle 385fta Inflatable Fishing Kayak features high quality design and construction that is second to none. This is a great fishing kayak for those new to kayak fishing as well as more experienced anglers. The high quality construction does make it little heavier than other inflatable fishing kayaks, but it is still easy to transport, easy to set up, and easy to get on and off the water.

2.) Sea Eagle 350fx Inflatable Fishing Kayak



The Sea Eagle 350fx Fishing Kayak is one of the best types of kayaks for solo kayak fishing. It has all the benefits of the larger 385fta, but with a paired down, smaller, one man-size. These features include EVA foam padding and thick 2000 denier reinforced panels for extra durability.

Benefits of inflatable kayaks in this size are the options for increased storage. At 11'6" it is a foot shorter than the 385fta Fishing Kayak. This makes it easier to handle, easier to navigate, and easier to carry. Not only can you customize the skirts, but you also have storage options underneath them.

This Sea Eagle Inflatable Fishing Kayak also features 16 high capacity self-bailing drain valves and is great for whitewater rapids up to Class IV. This make it an excellent option in rougher waters while the large removable skeg makes it also an excellent option in calm waters. The

high performance of Sea Eagle Kayaks is well known and their reputation for high quality inflatable kayaks dates back over 50 years!

3.) Advanced Elements StraitEdge Angler Pro 1 Person Fishing Kayak



The <u>Advanced Elements StraitEdge Angler Pro Inflatable Fishing Kayak</u> is one of the most stable types of fishing kayaks on the market. Its wide berth is designed so that you can easily stand up in the kayak, allowing you to reel in even the biggest of catches.

Drop stitch flooring with a high density drop stitch core makes this inflatable fishing kayak as sturdy, durable, and high performing as they come. Aluminum ribs are built into the bow and stern, adding to its sturdy design while enhancing performance and tracking.

The Advanced Elements StraitEdge Angler Pro also features an accessory frame system at the front and rear of the kayak. This makes the inflatable fishing kayak fully customisable so that you can tweek it exactly how you want it. An easy to remove deep-fin is in place to boost tracking on calm waters even more and if you really want to upgrade to an electric fin for a motorized fishing kayak.

The durability is enhanced with a polyester fabric surrounded by layers of vinyl that creates a PVC tarpaulin hull material that is extremely tough. Extra abrasion pads in high use areas add to the durability and make it long lasting. The solo fishing kayak seat has a capacity of up to 400lbs with gear, so you can bring everything that you will need. You can even attach an outboard motor should you wish.

The Advanced Elements StraitEdge Angler Pro is another great kayak fishing option that we highly recommend. The ability to customize it exactly to your ideal specifications is what separates it from other inflatable fishing kayaks.



4.) STAR Pike Inflatable Fishing Kayaks



The STAR Pike Inflatable Fishing Kayak is a great looking kayak that is extremely agile and on of the fastest fishing kayaks on the water. It is a durable inflatable fishing kayak, with a sleek design, great versatility, and great stability. At 12'8" long and 39 inches wide you have a firm base that allows you stand up to fish while maintaining stability.

Three separate air chambers and a drop stitch floors give the kayak its stability and durability and enhance the tracking and performance of the fishing kayak. Drop stitch material is the go-to option for creating a durable, high performing inflatable kayak that offers great stability. This inflatable kayak is self-bailing and is great in choppier waters.

Two removable fins (9" and 5") allow you to easily change options based on conditions. While it doesn't offer a fully customisable frame system it does feature 32 D-Rings, 2 nylon daisy-chains for storage behind the seat, 3 Scotty Mount attachment points, and and adjustable seat with back support. This is still a capable of giving you a great setup with plenty of options. Handles on either end of the inflatable fishing kayak make it easy to carry and get in and out of the water.

Amazingly, even with the heavy-duty PVC makeup, aluminum framed seat, mounts, and rigid keel inserts, it still only weights in at 45 pounds. This makes it ideal for anyone traversing both land and water, or someone who has camping gear and equipment with them. If you are looking for an inflatable fishing kayak that oozes efficiency, then the STAR Pike Inflatable Fishing Kayak may be the choice for you.



5.) Aquaglide Blackfoot Angler Inflatable Fishing Kayaks



The Aquaglide Blackfoot Angler Inflatable Fishing Kayak is a fantastic kayak that is available in 2 sizes. Built for sport and fishing, it is extremely agile in even the toughest conditions. There are 6 self-bailing drains so choppy waters are no problem. It is designed as a one person inflatable fishing kayak and can carry a load with gear up to 400lb.

It cites itself as being for the technical fisherman. The material is a heavy.duratex substance with a drop-stitch hard bottom floor for extra stability. It has all the features you would expect from a top of the range kayak, such as Scotty mounts and positrack rings. With all of the attachments and rings it can accommodate all of your accessories.

It is stable and well balanced and offers good performance on the water. You can stand up in the kayak and the Blackfoot Angler XL version features a raised seat, so the transition from standing to sitting and vice versa is easier than other models. Additionally, the Blackfoot XL raised seat sits on top of a cooler that you can keep your fish, or some ice cold beverages in. There is also velcro all along the floor so that you can adjust your seat and accessories exactly where you need them.

Named after the rugged terrain of the Blackfoot mountains, the Aquaglide Blackfoot Angler Inflatable Fishing Kayak lives up to its namesake. It has had glowing reviews since its redesign from the Blackfoot HB Angler SL and we are confident that you will find it an excellent choice.



Bonus Alternate Option #1: Sea Eagle FishSkiff 16 Inflatable Fishing Skiff



While this option is not an inflatable fishing kayak, it is somewhat similar and we wanted to include it here. The Sea Eagle FishSkiff 16 flirts the line between a kayak and an inflatable fishing boat. It can get you anywhere a bigger vessel would, without the fuss. The FiskSkiff 16 measures 16 feet in length and is made with 1000 Denier PVC material, so you know that you are getting a high-quality fishing skiff. This is an incredibly durable boat that is built to be long lasting, and showcases maximum performance.

One of the main advantages that you will see between the Sea Eagle FishSkiff 16 and inflatable fishing kayaks is area that you can cover with an outboard motor. This allows you to take the FishSkiff on longer excursions and get to different fishing spots quicker. A trolling motor is also often used with both the FishSkiff 16 and inflatable fishing kayaks, with a motormount.

The Sea Eagle FishSkiff comes with a plethora of options for customization, increasing its versatility and making it easier to catch more fish. The FishSkiff is completely self-bailing and features <u>low gunwales</u> that make it easy to both catch and release fish. These gunwales are also convenient for anyone wanting to snorkel or scuba as they allow you to easily slip in and out of the water.

You can seat two people with equipment and fish more than comfortably. There are two swivel seats that give you added comfort and allow you to quickly and easily stand up and sit down. At 16 feet long you can also go into rougher or deeper waters than you would be able to with an inflatable fishing kayak and the FishSkiff will also handle better in windy conditions.

This really is a different class than the inflatable fishing kayaks, but after reading all of this information you find that you are looking for something more, we would highly recommend the <u>Sea Eagle FishSkiff 16</u>. It is a fantastic inflatable fishing vessel.



Bonus Alternate Option #2: Sea Eagle FishSUP 126 Inflatable Fishing SUP



Similar to the balanced small fishing kayaks, the Sea Eagle FishSUP 126 Inflatable Fishing SUP is an excellent fishing option. It is different from an inflatable fishing kayak in that you stand or sit on top of the paddleboard. An inflatable fishing SUP works best in calmer, flat waters. There are so many features packed into this model, that the possibilities are endless.

It is made from premium 1000 denier material with a nonslip EVA foam deck. Its stability and buoyancy are increased by the inclusion of a swallowtail, that can also be used for an electric motor or battery pack. The inflatable fishing SUP features a 3'4" width that makes it incredibly stable and easy to fish. You can paddle it sitting down, like you are using an inflatable fishing kayak, or standing up.

The FishSUP 126 is 12'6" and designed for one person and has a capacity with gear of up to 350 lbs. It has small deflated dimensions and is lightweight whether inflated or not. This makes it an excellent choice for anyone who wants a fishing vessel but is searching for something even more lightweight and easy to transport than an inflatable fishing kayak.

This model is available in a fantastic range of discount packages. They include a start-up package, a deluxe package, and a swivel seat package. The swivel seat package features an incredibly comfortably seat with rod holders that allows you to fish as long as you want with no pain. There is a motor mount that allows you to install an electric trolling motor which really makes this a fishing machine. There are also 14 D-Rings that allow you to customize the inflatable fishing SUP to your needs.
