



CHOCOLATE CAMP

Chocolate Camp is a fun, curated program for campers that's infused with social impact and themed around chocolate making, tasting, and ethical cacao bean sourcing. The day includes a chocolate factory tour and tasting, a talk about social entrepreneurship, two carefully designed sessions, packed lunch on site, time for outdoor activities, plenty of kosher certified chocolate, and so much more!

MORNING SESSION

Cacao Pods

Moka will fly in fresh cacao fruits from our partner farm in Ecuador which campers will open up and harvest the cacao beans from. This will give campers a new appreciation for chocolate, as they taste the fresh cacao fruit and learn about the important role that farmers play in the chocolate supply chain.

Tree Planting

Next, the campers will plant the cacao beans they remove from the cacao fruit, giving them a solid understanding that the cacao bean is actually a seed.

Tour & Tasting

Campers will then join a professional Moka chocolate expert for a tour of our chocolate factory, and be led through a guided tasting of our chocolate. Each camper will receive a tasting platter and a flavor wheel, and be led through a 5 step tasting process that explains the differences between the chocolate bars and the origin where they are grown. They will hear about the farmers who grew each of the beans and the impact that sustainable chocolate makes.



AFTERNOON SESSION

Outdoor Activities

After lunch, campers will have around 45 minutes for outdoor activities and games in a field with a beautiful view of the mountains.

Chocolate Making Class

After some outdoor activities, we'll head to our chocolate making classroom for a chocolate making class where campers will make their own chocolate from raw cocoa bean to finished chocolate bar! Our expert staff will facilitate and guide campers through roasting, winnowing, and grinding of cocoa beans into a final liquid chocolate they can taste.

Shopping & Drinks

The day will end with shopping for chocolate, coffee, merch, and hot or cold drinks in our factory store and café. Each camper will receive a Chocolate Camp Completion Certificate as well as a free gift to take home.
