2017 MCM WINE CO. SUPERLIO VIOGNIER – YAKIMA VALLEY...... \$25

We present to you a totally new Viognier from MCM Wine Company that explores two exciting grapes from Dineen Vineyard in Zillah, Washington. This wine was raised by vineyard owner Pat Dineen and viticulturist Patrick Rawn. The wine began with 5 days of skin contact and was fermented naturally in seasoned French oak barrels, then kept on the lees with regular early stirring. ML is complete and adds depth and complexity. Bottled 1/5/19; 52 cases produced; Alcohol: 13.9%

89% Viognier (Dineen Vineyard) 11% Rousanne (Dineen Vineyard)

Barrels: This wine was aged for 16 months in seasoned French oak from Tonnellerie Doreau and Nadalie.

2017 MCM WINE COMPANY BRILLIA ROSÉ – YAKIMA VALLEY......\$20

Our Rosé exemplifies what Washington State can do with premium juices from the finest red grapes. Select juices from our red grape fermentations were extracted after crush in a process the French call saignée, or bleeding. The wine was raised in a seasoned French oak barrel, sur lie with bâtonage, and partial ML fermentation. It's dry with < .1g/L of sugar. Bottled 1/5/19; 28 cases produced; Alcohol: 13.7%

100% Saignée of Washington State red grapes (both Rhône-style and Bordeaux-style grapes)

Barrels: This wine was aged for 11 months in seasoned French oak from Alain Fouquet.

2016 MCM WINE COMPANY SPECTACULUXE SYRAH – COLUMBIA VALLEY......\$25

We crafted this Syrah dominant blend around the magnificent fruit from three distinguished vineyards: Ranch at the End of the Road near on Red Mountain near Benton City and Arianses Vineyard and Stone Tree Vineyard on the Wahluke Slope near Mattawa. Distinct locations with climates all their own contribute to a complex flavor profile of dark fruits, spices, savory edges. Bottled 8/4/18; 150 cases produced; Alcohol 14.6%

86% Syrah (49% Ranch at the End of the Road Vineyard, 37% Arianses Vineyard) 14% Grenache (StoneTree Vineyard)

Barrels: This wine was aged 22 months Export-style barrels, 50% seasoned American oak from A&K and Canton Cooperage, the balance in seasoned French oak from Ton. de Jarnac, Ton. Doreau, and Ton. Vernou.

2016 MCM WINE COMPANY MAJESTICA RED BLEND – COLUMBIA VALLEY......\$25

The decision to blend is always designed to maximize the effects of the components. Luckily this vintage gave us 10 interesting wines from five outstanding vineyards. We knew they would marry over time to form this deep rich wine with herbs and spices reflecting their varietal history and site. Dark berries and cherries overlaid with a dash of the French countryside on a dew drop morning with soft tannins creating an enjoyable lingering finish. Bottled 8/4/18; 275 cases produced; Alcohol 14.6%

57% Cabernet Sauvignon (34% StoneTree Vineyard, 8% Dineen Vineyard, 8% Arianses Vineyard, 4% Heart of the Hill Vineyard, 3% Ciel du Cheval)

17% Cabernet Franc (Dineen Vineyard)

17% Petit Verdot (Stone Tree Vineyard)

7% Merlot (4% Ciel du Cheval Vineyard, 3% Arianses Vineyard)

2% Malbec (Heart of the Hill Vineyard)

Barrels: This wine was aged 22 months Export-style barrels, 8% once used French oak from Quintessence and 15% once used American oak from Canton Cooperage, the balance in seasoned French oak from Darnajou, Demptos, de Jarnac, Ton. Vernou, and seasoned American oak from Canton.



This is our first release of Grenache for MCM Wine Company due to the extremely bountiful 2016 vintage. Vineyard owner Tedd Wildman was able to raise several extra barrels from our rows at StoneTree. We have long felt the urge to bottle Grenache on its own but have always used this fruit in our :Nota Bene Una Notte blend. It's showing soft and varietally intense with red fruits like strawberry and raspberry interwoven with spicy notes. We are so glad to be working with this fruit as these vines continue to mature and produce great wines. Bottled 8/4/18; 50 cases produced; Alcohol 14.9%

100% Grenache (StoneTree Vineyard)

Barrels: This wine was aged 22 months in Export-style barrels of seasoned American oak from A&K and seasoned French oak from Artisan Barrel Selections.
