A quarter of a century later, Bernoota has certainly grown into being a much-loved wine around the country, so much so that Bernoota-lovers trek around the world with it taking photos! (See our back page.)

I am happy to report, that on release of our 2016 Bernoota, the tradition continues with every vintage of Bernoota since 1992 having won at least one gold medal, with a medal tally in that time extending to 12 trophies and 49 gold medals.

But it's not all about medals, Bernoota is there to be enjoyed and we are proud to make it and thrilled you guys still love to drink it.

For those of you that haven't turned the bottle over and checked the back label, 'Bernoota' is the original name of Mum and Dad's house. It's an indigenous word meaning 'camp among the gum trees'.

To accentuate the strength of the 2016 reds, at the recent Australian Small Winemakers Show we walked away with 4 gold and 2 silver medals from our 6 entries, all from the 2016 vintage. To quote Greg, "we were a bees dick away from being awarded the Champion Small Winery Trophy".

The **2016 Cabernet Sauvignon** has already chalked up three gold medals.

VINEYARD REPORT

Handpicked Festival

As if we didn't think our Handpicked Festival couldn't get any bigger – this year it did!

Our quiet little backyard saw the hugest crowd ever. We had over 5000 music and wine lovers enjoy the most amazing event yet.

Its success is a huge credit to Kate, who has already commenced planning for next year!



We were lucky to spend a morning with Duncan Welgemoed and Nikki Friedli, from Adelaide's coolest restaurant, Africola. Duncan effortlessly prepared the most amazing King Fish at cellar door.

This was part of the South Australian Tourism's 'Rewards Wonder' campaign. An epc five days of constant filming, producing 120 hours of footage from across the state.

Royal Adelaide Show

The Adelaide Show has always been an important part of life for us, going right back to the early 1900's with Arthur Follett taking his shorthorn cattle and draft horses down to the show grounds. We even have an Adelaide Show trophy dating back to 1914.

Over the years, Ken has shown his Illawarra cattle and been actively involved on the Royal Agricultural Society committee for over 30 years.

Greg has been a member of the Wine Show Committee for the last 8 years and has just this year been elevated in status to Chair.

He's not so keen to don the suit and tie, he is much more comfortable in shorts and work boots!



Well, after a couple of wetter than average years, not unexpectedly this year has been extremely dry.

In fact, with rainfall of less than 200 mm in Langhorne Creek for the year to date, it is one of the driest on record.

Not surprisingly, the Bremer River failed to flow this year and no floods were experienced. This year has been reminding me a lot of 2006 which was also extremely dry and the beginning of the last big drought in the state.

The acquisition of a frost fan has helped minimize our frost risk this year and it seems we have dodged a bullet in this regard. Unfortunately, a few of our northern neighbours in the Barossa haven't been as lucky.

Tim and Josh are putting a lot of work into our older vines, cutting out dead wood and re-trellising. This work will continue over the next few years and is so important, to keep these valuable assets producing at a high level for the next 50 years.

We are also planting some more shiraz this year and next onto some of our non-floodplain ground. The consistency of shiraz on these red soils is fantastic so we are excited to see some of this fruit in the years to come.

I am also thrilled to report that the wine industry in general is as buoyant as I've seen in 15 years. Grape prices are on the rise and the demand for Langhorne Creek fruit is well and truly outstripping supply.


