One of Australia's emerging wine variety in is actually the most renowned red grape grown on the island of Sicily. The 'black grape of Avola' is well adapted to dry and hot conditions which helped shape our decision to plant when looking for a variety for the future.

Harvested, destemmed and open fermented with loads of whole berries present. Aged in five year old barriques for seven months prior to bottling unfinned and unfiltered.

The wine has a lifted floral perfume, with bright red fruits of redcurrant and pomegranate. The palate is light to medium bodied, deliciously juicy with a savoury edge and crunchy acidity.

Enjoy now with cured meats and soft cheese.
