The **National Museum of Singapore** is the nation's oldest museum established in 1887 when Singapore was part of the Straits Settlements. The museum, a National Monument now houses permanent exhibitions on Singapore history and popular culture, alongside changing exhibitions on world history and popular culture. It is Singapore's largest and most modern museum, using state-of-the-art multimedia technology to bring history to life.

Alongside the permanent galleries, the special exhibition galleries provide Singaporeans and visitors with the opportunity to learn more about world heritage and cultures here in Singapore, through major touring and special exhibitions presented in partnership with museums worldwide.

National Gallery Singapore occupies two national monuments: former Supreme Court and City Hall. Landmarks of Singapore's colonial past and journey to independence, the buildings have borne witness to many pivotal events in the nation's history.

Reflecting Singapore's unique heritage and geographical location, the Gallery features Singapore and Southeast Asian art in its long-term and special exhibitions. It will also work with leading museums worldwide to co-present Southeast Asian art in a wider context, positioning Singapore as a regional and international hub for the visual arts.
