National Gallery Singapore occupies two national monuments: former Supreme Court and City Hall. Landmarks of Singapore's colonial past and journey to independence, the buildings have borne witness to many pivotal events in the nation's history.

Reflecting Singapore's unique heritage and geographical location, the Gallery will feature Singapore and Southeast Asian art in its long-term and special exhibitions. It will also work with leading museums worldwide to co-present Southeast Asian art in a wider context, positioning Singapore as a regional and international hub for the visual arts.



Tickets are required for admission into all exhibition galleries and Keppel Centre for Art Education, except for the Concourse Galleries and the Ng Teng Fong Roof Garden Gallery.
