Software Required:

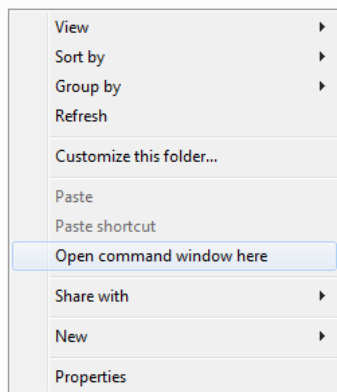
NSSM <http://nssm.cc/>

ClockComms <http://www.bundyplus.com.au/downloads.php>


Once NSSM has been downloaded go to the NSSM folder and open either Win64 or Win32 depending on your OS architecture.

You will see an exe called NSSM.exe, shift right click and you will get an option to open a command window in the folder location.

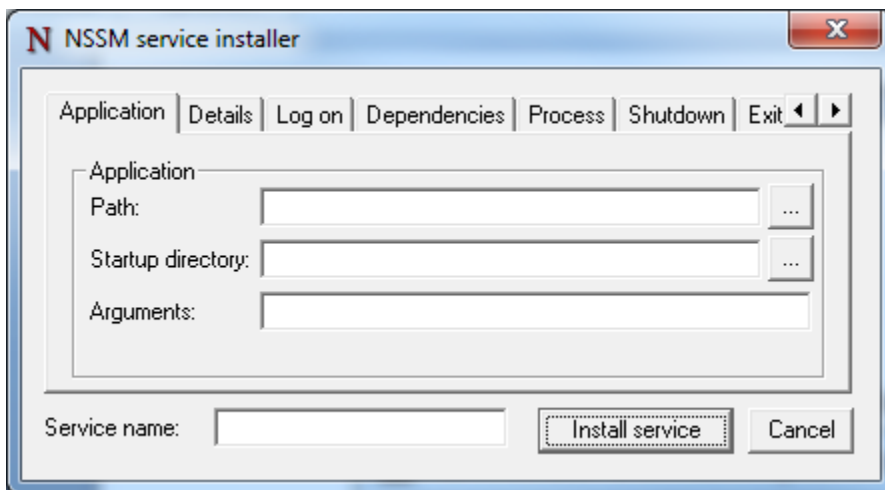


Now from the command window type nssm install and hit enter:

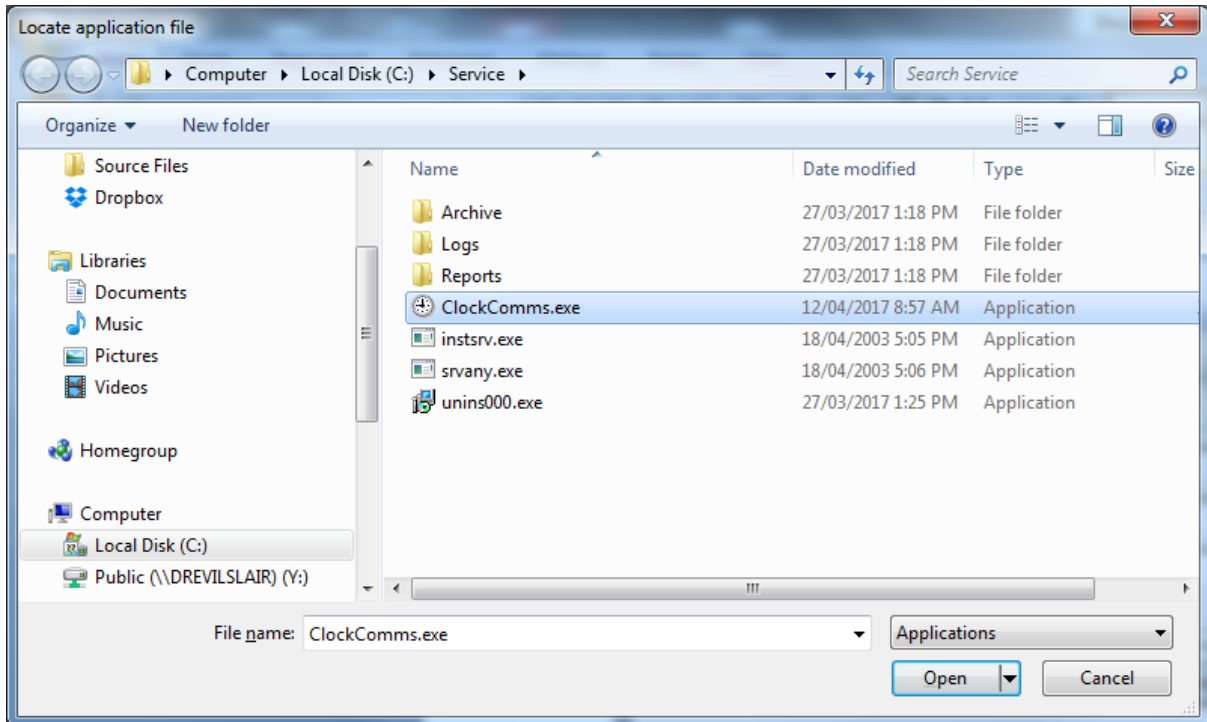
    nssm reset <servicename> <parameter> [<subparameter>]
To show service removal GUI:
    nssm remove [<servicename>]
To remove a service without confirmation:
    nssm remove <servicename> confirm
To manage a service:
    nssm start <servicename>
    nssm stop <servicename>
    nssm restart <servicename>
    nssm status <servicename>
    nssm rotate <servicename>

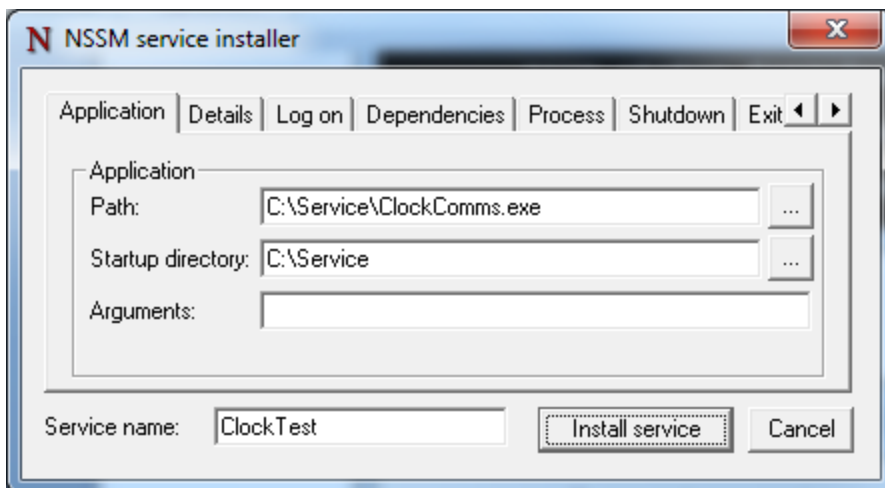
Now you will have a window similar to the image above open on your screen.

Click the 3 dots next to path and navigate to where ClockComs.exe is sitting and click ClockComms

and then hit open.

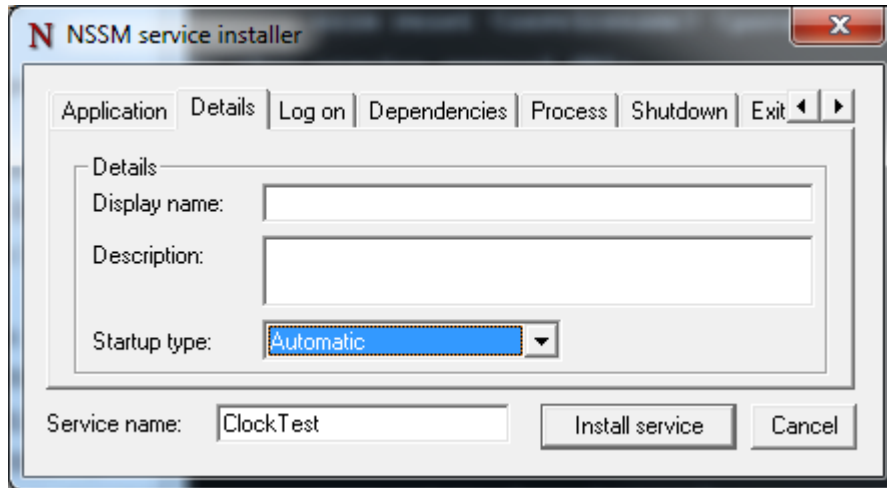


Now you will receive a window like below, enter the Service name (remember to make it something that you will recognise)



Now if you want to change the Startup type to Manual /Disabled/Delayed start go to Details and change it from the dropdown box at the bottom.

If you wish you can enter in a display name and a brief description however this is optional.



Then once you hit install you are done!
