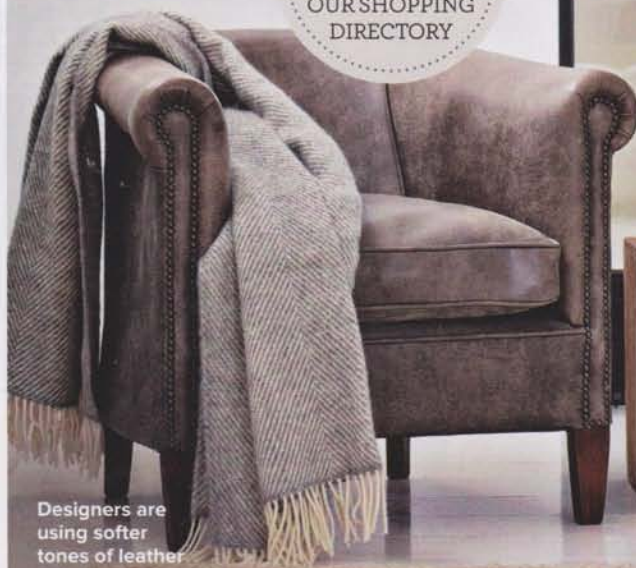

THE STORY SO FAR There's nothing new about leather in interiors – it has always been synonymous with luxury and smart finishes. However, today's designers are exploring this tactile material by using leather in less structured forms; it's either woven, given sculpted edges or patterned finishes in soft or natural tones, held together with simple fixtures. **WHERE WE'VE SEEN IT** Berlin-based design company Daniel Heer combines simple wood frames and wide, untreated-leather strips for unusual furniture. With the Brogue side table, Welsh designer Bethan Gray plays with colour and pattern, edged with an intricate brogue pattern and paired with light oak, from £895. **LATEST RELEASES** New York design studio byAMT's Strap storage collection has soft, nude-coloured straps held together by copper rivets, while Alp designer Annick L Peterson uses both woven strips of leather and pinkish-shear edges to form furniture and accessories. We love her beech-frame mirrors with leather hanging straps. Camengo's new range, Mixology, is a fabric range of faux leather in a soft, grainy finish, £31.20 per m.
