THE FACTS

According to the World Wildlife Fund, an area the size of 300 football fields of vi gin rainforest is cleared each hour to make way for palm oil production.

Species like the Orangutan could become extinct in the wild within the next 5-10 years, and the Sumatran Tiger the next 3 years.

50 million tons of palm oil are produced annually. It is found in 40-50% of household products, from baked goods to tooth paste.

Over 90% of Orangutan habitat has been destroyed in the last 20 years; the UN has called it a "conservation emergency."

1000-5000 Orangutans are killed each year for this development.

TIPS

The EU now requires labels to specifically list palm oil; however, elsewhere, palm oil can still be listed simply as "vegetable oil." If it's a food product, check the saturated fat content; if it's over 40%, it's likely palm oil.

In beauty products many oils and butters add "label value." If they list "vegetable oil," it's usually because they're hiding something (i.e. palm oil.)

Opt for naturally saponified soaps, SLS-free washes, and emulsifier-free scrubs, body butters, oils and balms.
