

Everything starts in 1896, when great-grand-father Gilles Ranno, carpenter, decides to work in fairsovertheworldtoescapefamilyroutine.Thegrand-fatherPierreChénel,carpenter-electrician, takesover. The father, architect and inventor, develops the company under the name Chénel SA, a general setup company employing up to 400 people. 1991 will constitute an important turn when the Unions exert power. The company goes into bankruptcy and is sold to Olivier Ginon (Générale Location). GuyChénelconcentratesonPROCÉDÉSCHÉNELINTERNATIONAL, at that time as mall company of 9 employees focused on overseas markets. In 1994, Sophie Chénel, the daughter, successfully joinsthefamilycompany,concentratingonexportsales-about25% of the turnover-andonsocietal and environmental responsability. PCI's baseline becomes «architecture of paper». Sophie multiplies the uses of the various fire-resistant materials, working on more and more killer applications. An exemplary family journey around ephemeral paper.

Drop[°] Cake is created from Drop[°] Paper waste (60%) and polyethylene waste (40%). It allows us to recycle all our production scraps and decorations after use. It is obtained from the shredding of these two materials and then by hot pressing
