



GO! Fun at Sea Throw Quilt

Finished Size: 33-1/2" x 33-1/2"







Dies Needed:

GO! Qube Mix & Match 12" Block (55778)

- GO! Half Square Triangle-6" Finished Square (Shape 3)
- GO! Quarter Square Triangle-6" Finished Square (Shape 4)

Additional Dies Needed

- GO! Sea Life Medley (55190)
- GO! Circle-6" (55384)
- GO! Strip Cutter-1 1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2 1/2" (2" Finished) (55017)
- GO! Strip Cutter-3 1/2" (3" Finished) (55032)

Fabric Requirements:

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
White	1/2 yard for background
Blue	1-1/2 yards for blocks and outer border
Teal Blue	3/4 yard for blocks
Yellow Orange	1/2 yard for applique and inner border
Orange	1/4 yard for applique
Black	a 9" x 21" piece for applique
Double-sided fusible interfacing	3/4 yard
Blue	1/3 yard each for binding
Batting	2-3/4 yards
Backing	2-3/4 yards





Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Die	Number of Shapes to Cut
Blue, Teal Blue and White	GO! Half Square Triangle-6" Finished Square (Shape 3)	Cut 13 each, 6" half square triangles, from blue and teal blue fabrics. Cut 8—6" half square triangles from white background fabric.
White	GO! Quarter Square Triangle-6" Finished Square (Shape 4)	Cut 4—6" quarter square triangles from white background fabric.
Orange and Black	GO! Sea Life Medley (55190)	Apply double-sided fusible interfacing, to the wrong side of the fabric and then cut out 1 crab, 1 seahorse, 1 starfish, 1 fish from orange and 11 circles from black.
Yellow Orange	GO! Circle-6" (55384)	Cut out 4—6" circles from the yellow orange fabric.
Yellow Orange	GO! Strip Cutter 1-1/2" (1" Finished) (55024)	Cut 4—1-1/2" strips from yellow orange fabric for inner border.
Blue	GO! Strip Cutter 3-1/2" (3" Finished) (55032)	Cut 4—3-1/2" strips from the blue fabric for the outer border
Blue	GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55017)	Cut 4 blue 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.





Sewing Directions

Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.


TWO TONE HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE BLOCK

NOTE: Directions will be for one 6" finished block. Make a total of 13 blocks.

1. These blocks may be sewn together by chain piecing, which means to sew all 13 blocks without breaking the threads in between sewing each block. Lay out a teal and blue 6" half square triangle. (HST)



2. Sew the blue and teal HSTs together along the long diagonal edge as shown in the diagram to the right.




Press toward the blue HST. Make 13 of these blocks.



APPLIQUE SHAPES

4. Apply double-sided fusible interfacing to the wrong side of the orange fabric. With a ruler cut the orange fabric, with interfacing, into a square that is 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" for the starfish.




6. Repeat this process for cutting out a seahorse, fish and crab from the orange fabric. The size of the orange fabric, with interfacing, for the crab is 3-1/2"x 5"; the seahorse is 5" x 3" and the fish is 3-1/2" x 4-1/2". Apply >double-sided fusible interfacing, to the wrong side of the black fabric and cut out 11 small black circles.









7. Using the free downloadable embroidery that comes with the Sea Life Medley die, machine applique the starfish onto the yellow orange background circle, using tear away stabilizer. You may need to float the circle on top of the hoop. The embroidery file will first stitch a placement line and then you will remove the fusible paper's backing and fuse the starfish in place. Place the shape accurately within the stitched placement line for best results. If you want to add the black circles to the top of your starfish, the embroidery file also has a circle shape. You will need to make sure that you position the circle to stitch in the correct location within your hoop, as it will not do it automatically.




9. Lay out the (8) white 6" half square triangles, the (4) quarter square triangles and the 13 blocks completed in #3 above. Notice the orientation of the blocks in the diagram below.



10. Sew the white half square triangles, white quarter square triangles and the HST squares together in diagonal rows. Press the rows in alternate directions per the red arrows in the diagram below.











11. Apply double-sided fusible interfacing, to the wrong side of the yellow orange fabric circles with the Sea Life applique on them. Fuse in place, following the manufacturer's directions, onto the center HST squares per the diagram to the right. Machine applique around the outer edge of each circle with a blanket stitch.




Sewing inner and outer borders

- 1. Sew yellow-orange 1-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of the guilt top center. Press toward the yellow orange inner border. Trim the side inner borders even with the top and bottom of the guilt top.
- 2. Sew yellow orange 1-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top center. Press toward the yellow orange inner border. Trim the top and bottom inner borders even with the side inner borders.



- 3. Sew blue 3-1/2" strips to the left and right sides of the quilt top center. Press toward the blue outer border. Trim the side outer borders even with the top and bottom inner border.
- 4. Sew blue 3-1/2" strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top center. Press toward the blue outer border. Trim the top and bottom outer border even with the side outer border.







Quilting and Finishing

- Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
- Pin or baste layers together. 2.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- Add blue binding, mitering corners.
