
Supplies:

- · Pattern will be supplied in class
- Refer to the diagram of one block below for choosing fabrics:



- A 80 assorted 5"x5" squares (usually 2 charm packs or 20 Layer Cake 10" squares)
- B & E- 6 assorted Fat Quarters or .2m of six assorted fabrics
- C&D-.3m
- F- .9 m
- Borders- .8 m if 3 ½" wide to make 54 x 66 quilt or 1 m if 5 ½" wide to make 59 x 70 quilt
- 6 ½" or 8 ½" x 24 " ruler
- 6 ½" x 6 ½" ruler, plus a larger square ruler, if you have one
- Rotary cutter
- · Pencil or marking pen
- 6 Sealable/zipper plastic bags
- Not essential, but a Creative Grids slotted ruler makes cutting much quicker and more accurate

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Pre cutting required before class:

If you do not understand these instructions, wait to cut the fabric. It will delay starting to sew, but "better safe than sorry".

Charm squares or Layer Cakes-

- -select 80 charm squares and put in Bag A
- -or, if using 10" layer cakes, cut into (4) 5"x5" squares to make 80 and put in Bag A

Fat Quarters (or .2m of 6 fabrics)

- 1. -From each Fat Quarter or .2m of fabric, cut (14) 2" x 5" -place (84)- 2" x 5" in Bag B
- 2. From **each** Fat Quarter or .2m of fabric, cut (6) 2" x 2" -place (36) 2" x 2" in **Bag E**

From yardage of Star Centers (C), cut (1) 2" x wof -Sub cut into (20) 2' x 2" and place in Bag C

From yardage of Star Points (D), cut (4) 2" x wof -sub cut into (80) 2" x 2" and place in Bag D

From yardage for large sashing (F), cut (17) 2" x wof -Sub cut into (49) 2" x 11" strips and place in Bag F

Border fabric will be cut later

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
