Fundraising Opportunities:

-Dine to Donate: Consists of dining out on assigned dates at a particular restaurant to support TSC.

Payout: The restaurant(s) will make a donation to Troy Skating Club general account.

-Kroger Community Rewards: Consists of registering TSC on your Kroger Account as charity of choice.

Payout: TSC general account will automatically receive a donation from Kroger just for you shopping.

-Amazon Smile: Consists of registering your amazon account with TSC as your charity of choice and shopping at www.amazonmile.com

Payout: TSC general account will automatically receive a donation from Amazon Smile just for you shopping.

-Spirit Wear: Consists of purchasing TSC spirit wear from Western Ohio Graphics through our online store at www.troyskatingclub.org or at Western Ohio Graphics location.

Payout: Western Ohio Graphics will automatically make a donation into TSC general account.

Read and sign TSC's Annual Fundraising Contract, Check your email and sign up for events at signup.com

***Note:** Some events require additional training which must be done prior to sign ups for those events.

-Hobart Clean up: consists of 1 ½-2 hours of arena clean up after Hobart events. All equipment is provided and children are welcome to help if they are able to work in a focused manner for the entire time frame.

Payout: \$250 per event to TSC. \$250 will be divided equally among the number of participants, not to exceed 10 participants per event.

-Hobart Concessions: *Additional training required by Hobart Concessions Manager. Consists of working concession stands during Hobart Arena sponsored events.

Payout: Minimum payout is \$300 per event. This amount earned for this event is divided equally among the participants, maximum of 10 per event.

-Dayton Dragons Concessions: *Additional training required by Dayton Dragons staff. Consists of being assigned to a specific concession area during a Dragons game at 5/3 Field during 2019 season.

Payout: After the season has ended, the fundraising total will be divided equally among the number of participants at each game during the 2019 season. This opportunity will be reassessed for the 2020 season.

Fundraising credits will remain on your account (NO cash transactions) and are non-transferable between family accounts. You must request to use your credits toward eligible goods/services within TSC at the time payment is due. All fundraising credits expire one (1) year after the date of the event in which the funds were raised. Any unused value on the expiration date will be deposited into TSC general account, and for that amount you will receive a 501(c)3 tax deductible receipt on the expired portion on which you earned from the TSC Treasurer.
