

**OFF-LICENCE
(for premises)**

Sections 17 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **KATIE LOUISE DOUGLAS** (the licensee) is authorised to sell by remote sale and deliver alcohol from the premises situated at **20 Coates Avenue, Baylys Beach, Kaipara District**, and known as "**Gift Box Boutique**", to any person for consumption off the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is for remote sales only and is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) No alcohol is to be delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- (b) **No alcohol is to be delivered to the buyer (or any other person on the buyer's behalf) at any time after 11.00pm on any day and before 6.00am on the next day.**
- (c) Alcohol may be sold via remote sales on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday (7 days) 24 hours
- (d) The fees payable for the licensing of the premises concerned are the following risk rating: **Low**.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from Coates Avenue is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—


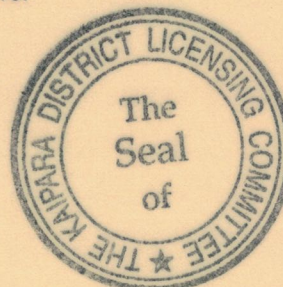
- (a) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, the licence expires on:

The 01st day of November 2020

The licensed premises are more precisely identified as outlined in the floor plan date stamped as received by the Kaipara District Licensing Committee on 12 July 2016.

- (1) The licensee's attention is drawn to s.49 of the Act under which remote sales are exempted from trading hour restrictions and allow a remote sale of alcohol to be made at any time on any day. Subsection 49(1) (a) overrides the restrictions on sales imposed by ss. 46 and 48; but (b) is subject to the restrictions on delivery imposed by ss. 48 and 59(1); and
- (2) Section 59 of the Act in particular s.59(3) where the holder of an off licence must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer of any alcohol that the holder sells by remote sale (and, if a person other than the buyer is to receive it, to verify that the receiver) is not under the purchase age.
