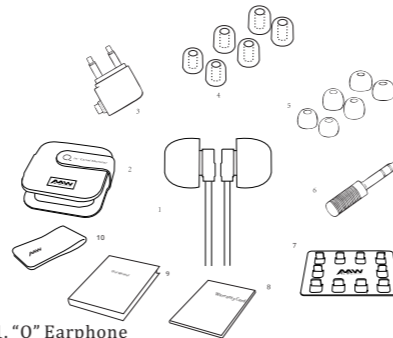

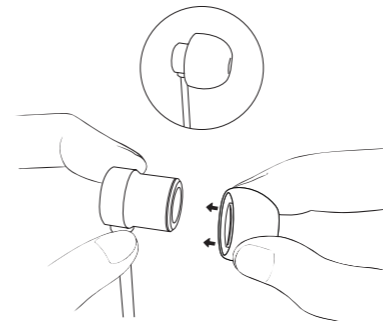
Choosing and attaching ear sleeve Connecting earphone to a device Wearing the earphone

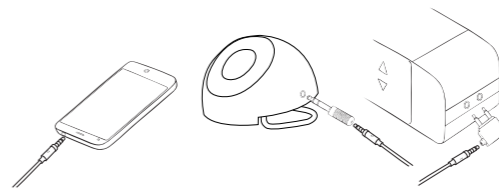
90db SPL @ 8hours

1. "Q" Earphone

10. Leather Cable Clip



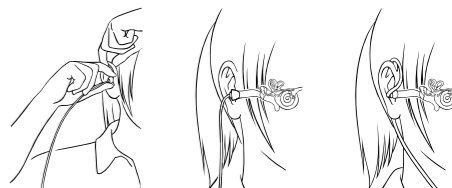
1. Please choose the right eartip for comfortable fitting and good sound quality.
2. A tight seal between the eartip and your ear canal is good for sound quality. If there seems to be a lack of bass, try a different ear sleeve.
3. When you change the eartip, twist and pull out the sleeve from the nozzle
4. After attaching the new eartip, please make sure it completely covers the nozzle to secure the fit



Earphones can be connected to a device with **3.5mm jack**

Earphones can be connected to a device with ¼ inch (6.35mm) input jack by using the **¼ inch (6.35mm) adaptor**

Earphones can be connected to the airline seat during the flight by using the **flight adaptor** for your in-flight entertainment.



1. Choose the right size of the eartip. Insert the "Q" into your ear canal and make sure it is inserted far enough for good seal.
2. Two ways to wear the "Q"
 - a. Straight down in front
 - b. Over the ear at back
