WMX Championship title in 2019 with a 'near perfect' year where she won nine of the 10 races in the championship. In 2020 she had to work a little harder for the championship, battling down to the wire for the gold plate. This is where the Kiwi's determination shone through and her tenacity in those final moments was enough to secure her, her second world title.
