Directions to the monastery from I-64:

- Take exit #8, Hwy 152, and head south.
- Drive about 14 miles, until you pass a sawmill on your right.
- Take the next left turn. This is Wilson Creek Road. Note: You will see a sign which reads "Holy Cross Monastery".
- Go 4.1 miles on Wilson Creek Road, keeping to the left at the first fork (follow the double yellow lines).
- Turn right at Miller's Fork Road (there is another monastery sign).
- Drive about 1.5 miles on Millers Fork Road.
- Take Left Fork of Miller's Fork Road, and go 2.2 more miles.
- Watch for a large "Holy Cross Monastery" sign on your right.
- Turn right at the sign onto the gravel road over the large culvert; this is our driveway.
- Bear left up the gravel road, past the sign and a large cross, about half a mile. (For some events, there may be controlled parking below the monastery, with shuttle service provided.)

<u>Directions to Holy Spirit Orthodox Church from the Monastery:</u>

- From the monastery, return to Hwy 152 and turn right.
- Continue 15 miles. Church is visible from Hwy 152, on the left side behind the "Speedway" gas station.
- The address of the church is 1 Woodhaven Dr., Huntington, WV.
- The banquet hall is to the far right of the main entrance to the church.
