- ½ yard (45.72cm x 106.68cm) 17319-MLT-CTN-D (Allover Floral)
- 1/3 yard (30.48cm x 106.68cm) 17316-MLT-CTN-D (Plumes)
- 1/3 yard (30.48cm x 106.68cm) 17265-NVY-CTN-D (Navy Posy) from the 3W Summer Song Collection

### **Additional Supplies Needed:**

- 5% yard Fusible Fleece
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)

# Before You Begin


Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " (6.35mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

# Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of pieces from each fabric listed below.



**24" Panel (17315-WHT-CTN-D) 3 yard (60.96cm x 106.68cm)** Fussy Cut 2 - 11 ½" x 15 ½" (29.21cm x 39.37cm)

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




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# Sewing

- 1. Refer to Diagram A to sew the Navy Posy strips (2" x 15 ½" / 5.08cm x 39.37cm) RST to each side of the Zebra panel 11 ½" x 15 ½" (29.21cm x 39.37cm). Sew the Navy Posy strips (2" x 14 ½" / 5.08cm x 36.83cm) RST to the top and bottom of the Zebra Panel to make the Bag Front. Trim to measure 13" x 17" (33.02cm x 43.18cm) after borders are added.
- 2. Refer to Diagram B to sew the Allover Floral strips (3 ¼" x 17" / 8.26cm x 43.18cm) RST to each side of the Bag Front. Sew the Allover Floral strips (2 ¼" x 18 ½" / 5.72cm x 46.99cm) RST to the top and bottom to make the Bag Front which measures 18 ½" x 20 ½" (46.99cm x 52.07cm).
- 3. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 referring to Diagram C for fabric identification to make the 18 ½" x 20 ½" (46.99cm x 52.07cm) Bag Back.



- 4. Follow the manufacturer's instructions to fuse the fleece to the wrong side of the Pineapples rectangles (18 ½" x 20 ½" / 46.99cm x 52.07cm) to make the Bag Front and Back.
- 5. Quilt in the ditch between border strips.
- 6. To make the Straps, fold one Plumes strip (4" x 42" / 10.16cm x 106.68cn) in half lengthwise and press. Refer to Diagram D to open the folded fabric and fold each long edge to the creased centerline and press. Fold the pressed fabric in half again and press to make one 1" x 42" (2.54cm x 106.68cm) Plumes strip. Top stitch 1/8" (3.18mm) from the edges to make one Strap. Repeat to make a second Strap. Trim the Straps to the desired length.



7. To make the lining, refer to Diagram E to place the two Pineapple rectangles 18 ½" x 20 ½" (46.99cm x 52.07cm) RST and pin. Sew the sides and bottom leaving a 4" (10.16cm) opening for turning.





8. Refer to Diagram F to pin each end of the Strap to the Bag Back 1" (2.54cm) from each corner and sew. Repeat to attach the second Strap to the Bag Front.





9. Refer to Diagram G and place the Bag Back and Bag Front RST, with the Straps sandwiched between the layers. Sew the sides and bottom to make the Bag. Turn the Bag right side out.



10. Refer to Diagram H to slide the Bag/Straps into the Lining, RST. Align the top edges, pin and sew.



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11. Refer to Diagram I to turn the bag right side out through the opening in the Lining and press. Stitch the opening in the Lining closed and push the Lining into the Bag. Press the top edge and top stitch ¼" (6.35mm) from the edge.



# Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. *Tip:* Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.

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
