

Tea at Dharmsala

In 1882, our great-great grandparents came to Dharmsala and immediately fell in love with the beautiful, lush green tea slopes and the majestic, snow-capped Himalayan peaks. That year, when they founded The Dharmsala Tea Company, the Kangra District Gazette described the tea as 'superior to that produced in any other part of India'.

Kangra Valley is as lush, beautiful and naturally endowed today as it was when George Barnes wrote in his Report on Settlements in the District of Kangra in 1855:


I know no spot in the Himalayah which, for beauty or grandeur, can be compared with the Kangra Valley and these overshadowing hills. No scenery, in my opinion, presents such sublime and delightful contrasts. Below lies the plain, a picture of rural loveliness and repose. The surface is covered with the richest cultivation, irrigated by streams which descend from perennial snows, and interspersed with homesteads buried in the midst of groves and fruit trees. Turning from this scene of peaceful beauty, the stern and majestic hills confront us. Their sides are furrowed with precipitous water-courses; forests of oaks clothe their flanks, and higher up, give place to gloomy and funereal pines. Above all, are wastes of snow, or pyramidal masses of granite, too perpendicular for the snow to rest on.



With such subliminal beauty and peace surrounding our tea gardens in Dharmsala, we have worked hard to ensure that over the decades, our tea remains evocative of our core values of simplicity, naturalness, purity, love, and sustainability.

Today, Dharmsala tea is about so much more than just tea. It's advocating a way of life. Culture, philosophy, art, health, friends and nature intersect in Dharmsala, a place that inspires and moulds our values, a place with which our family has been associated for over 135 years. We want to embrace modernity, but not lose what's precious from our past. We want to advance, but not at a pace that adversely affects our health. We want to evolve, but not lose sight of the values that keep us grounded. Its balance that we seek.

In all the rushed madness of today's world, we want our teas to transport you to Dharmsala, a place of peace, calm, and tranquility. So come, take this journey with us.



Each layer is so rich with colorful stories that showcase timeless values - the victory of good over evil, light over darkness and knowledge over ignorance.

Each of the teas in our Five Days of Diwali Collection therefore celebrates those simple yet incredibly powerful stories. The collection revolves around elements that represent Diwali and the warmth, togetherness, color, vibrancy, and light associated with Diwali celebrations starting from Dhanteras and ending with Bhai Dooj.

Our tea blends with rose (gulab), marigold (genda), saffron (kesar), cardamom (elaichi), almonds (badam) will evoke the nostalgia of the festive flavors and aromas emanating from boxes of mithai and dry fruits heaped around us amidst the prayers and ceremonies of Diwali.

Diwali, much like Indian weddings, is a celebration and coming together of people, friends, and families. But more importantly, in an India where many of us live away from our families and closest friends for most of the year, the homecoming of our loved ones is cause for cheer all around. DAY 1: DHANTERAS "THE DAY OF FORTUNE"






SAFFRON CARDAMOM TEA




MARIGOLD TEA

DAY 4: GOVARDHAN POOJA "THE NEW YEAR"




THE MASALA THUNDERSTORM




THE POST-FESTIVITIES BLEND


