CLOTHES

- Lightweight, long-sleeved shirts
- Breathable pants or shorts
- Wide brimmed hat
- Jacket
- Swimsuit
- Underwear and socks
- Sleepwear
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Sandals or flip flops

IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS

- Passport
- Driver's license
- Reservation confirmations
- Visa's if applicable
- Safari itinerary
- Safari guidebook (for animal identification)

ACCESSORIES

- Sunglasses
- Binoculars
- Jet&Bo cashmere travel wrap
- Water bottle
- Backpack
- Headlamp or flashlight
- Waterproof dry bags

TOILETRIES

- Shampoo and conditioner
- Hair styling products and tools
- Moisturizer
- Toothbrush, toothpaste, and floss
- Razor and shaving cream
- Perfume, cologne, or aftershave
- Deodorant
- Makeup

MEDICAL

- Prescription medications
- Pain relievers
- Hand sanitizer
- Sunscreen
- Lip Balm
- Insect Repellant

ELECTRONICS

- Tablet
- Smartphone
- Headphones or earbuds
- Charging cables for all devices
- Converter, if traveling internationally
- Portable charger
- Camera with zoom capabilities and batteries

NOTE

- Pack lightweight, moisture-wicking clothing suitable for warm temperatures during the day and cooler temperatures at night.
- Choose neutral-colored clothing to blend in with the natural surroundings and avoid bright colors that may startle wildlife.
- Check with your safari operator or lodge for specific packing recommendations and any additional items you may need for your safari experience.
- Be prepared for unpredictable weather conditions and changes in temperature by layering clothing and packing accordingly.
