

Sucseed Start-up Guide Checklist

Thanks for joining SucSeed! We're excited to expand our community of healthy growing and eating. These instructions will help you get setup for the best yield. Be sure to take a look.



SUCSEED

A. Getting Started

1. Place 12 black pots in holes of the system
2. Place two handfuls of rock wool in all 12 pots (about 40% of the pot)
3. Place submersible pump at the bottom inside the basin (Make sure the suction cup sticks so it stays underwater)
4. Attach pump hose to the black hose running underneath the yellow lid
5. Pull the pump cord through hole on side of the system
Do NOT plug-in the pump until later
6. Add 32L of water to system reservoir
7. Test water to ensure the pH is around 6.0
8. If pH level is too high, add some lemon juice to lower it, if levels are too low, add some baking soda and stir

B. Mixing the Nutrients

For Leafy Greens/Herbs:

1. Add 32 ml of Optimum A to the basin and stir.
2. Add 32 ml of Optimum B to basin and stir
3. Test the pH level and compare colour of tube to chart. If pH level is too high, add some lemon juice to lower it, if levels are too low, add some baking soda and stir
4. Re-check Ph until it is around 6.0

For Flowering Plants:

1. Add 32 ml of Optimum A to the basin and stir.
2. Add 32 ml of Optimum B to the basin and stir
3. Test the pH level and compare colour of tube to chart. If levels are too high, add lemon juice, if levels are too low, add baking soda
4. Stir and re-check pH until it is around 6.0

C. Planting the Seeds

9. Dip the pots of rockwool in nutrient water in the basin
10. Break apart 2 rockwool cubes from each pot to form an opening
11. Place 2-3 seeds in the middle of each rockwool cube, then squeeze the cubes back together
12. Place the cubes back into the pot amongst other rockwool cubes
13. Seeds are ready for germination!

D. Finishing Touches

1. Plug in the system and wait for your seeds to sprout
2. Mount the grow light six to eight inches above the plant
3. Once one plant sprouts turn on the light
