

Latex Statement: As of January 1, 2006, DuPont production specifications exclude use of components containing natural rubber latex in the manufacture of DuPontTM Tyvek® (soClean® and ProClean® garments. Anyone who begins to exhibit allergic response during the use of DuPont products should immediately cease using these products. The incident should also be reported to DuPont at 1.800.441.3637.
