PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

BASIC USE : Centennial Woods offers naturally weathered reclaimed wood products for interior and exterior design applications. The aged wood has an appearance suited for exterior siding, interior walls, ceilings, fixtures and furniture. All products are FSC® Recycled 100%, untreated, free of toxins, lead paint, and animal waste — making it safe for residential and commercial use.

MATERIAL ORIGIN : Centennial Woods products come from a single source called "Snow Fence", which the company builds near roadways and on the open ranges of Wyoming. Snow fences are constructed using fresh boards, of a high altitude pine species. The wood is aged naturally during a 7–10 year long weathering cycle prior to the reclamation process. During this time, Centennial Woods also performs maintenance, keeping the fences in good repair.

COMPOSITION & SIZES : Products are sold in consistent dimensions. (See Table).

COLORS: The naturally weathered patina presents a range of gray and brown tones from light to dark, with a mix of cinnamon hues, as well as some blacks. No paints or chemicals are used on the natural wood. Ferrous staining may be present in nail holes. Alternative tones and finish options are created through various sanding techniques (e.g. - flap sanding, skip planing), paints, and stains. Custom finishes available upon request.

SEALANT OPTIONS : NOTE - Sealant options do not change patina or look of wood.

TECHNICAL DATA

PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS : Centennial Woods' products have low VOC discharge and possess medium hardness typical of pine species.

MOISTURE CONTENT : Moisture content ranges from four to eight percent.

PHYSICAL PROPERTIES : Class: Only Centennial Woods' products appropriately treated with Flamestop II® fire retardant can be considered Class A. Without Flamestop II® treatment, Weathered Wood Nominal 1x6 is considered Class B, all other milled prodcuts are considered Class C.

INSTALLATION
