Tips for writing your signature

- Use a ball point pen or fine point marker with dark ink. No pencils please.
- Write your name on plain white paper or print this page and sign your name in the box.
- No spaces can be used between names Mary Ann will be created as MaryAnn.
- Make your entire signature visible. Apply consistent pressure to all lines and curves.
- Include a print copy of your name to help ensure that we make your signature correctly.
- If your signature contains an extremely large first letter and the rest of your name is written much smaller, your pendant may look disproportionate. For a more balanced looking pendant, try to write your name with proportionate capital and lower case letters.

For signatures that have long "tails" or lines with no height, we may need to adjust the thickness of your pendant. Your signature may not be the exact size you have written, as the pendant may need to be slightly adjusted to in order for us to manufacture the best quality item for your enjoyment.



Tips for photographing and uploading your signature
