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Written for the Wild and Wooly 2023 Yarn Crawl, the Cables and Rib Hat is the perfect introduction to cables for the adventurous beginner! With a folded 3x3 rib this hat will keep you warm throughout the coldest months of the year. The ribbing transitions beautifully into the cable and rib design. The cable features one left and one right leaning cross, which is perfect for a beginner to advance their skills and easy to memorize for more advanced knitters.

#Cables And Rib Hat

CABLE AND RIB HAT

SIZES

Size 1 (2) Adult (Adult XL)

MATERIALS

2 skeins Brooklyn Tweed Arbor (145 yd / 50g) in Burnished Or 1 skein Salty Blonde DK (231 yd / 100g) in Cloverfield Or 230 (245) yards of DK weight varn

*The larger size uses almost an entire skein of Salty Blonde DK. We suggest either getting an extra skein or omit the folded brim for the larger size.

TOOLS

Needle A: US 4 (3.5mm) 16" circular needle

Needle B: US 6 (4mm) 16" circular needle

Needle C: US 6 (4mm) DPNS or your preferred method for crown decreases

Stitch marker Tapestry Needle Cable needle

GAUGE

23 sts & 30 rows = 4" in crown rib and cable pattern, blocked

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 19.5" (22.75") circumference after blocking.

Choose a hat that has roughly 1-2" of negative ease for a snug fit.



ABBREVIATIONS

K: knit

P: Purl

mlL: make 1 left

st(s): stitch(es)

Cn: cable needle

6-st RC: SI 3 sts to cn and hold to back, K3, K3 from cn.

6-st LC: Sl 3 sts to cn and hold to front, K3, K3 from cn

K2tog: knit 2 sts together

P2tog: purl 2 sts together

SSK: slip, slip, knit. Slip the next two sts knitwise, insert the left needle into the fronts of these stitches and knit them together.

CAST ON

With needle A, cast on 108 (126) sts using German Twisted cast on.

Place marker, and join in the round

Rnd 1: [K3,P3] to end of the round.

Repeat Rnd 1 until your hat measures 2.75"

Rnd 2: K to end of the round.

This creates a purl ridge when your brim is folded up. Repeat Rnd 1 until your hat measures 5.5" from the cast on edge.

HAT

Switch to needle B

Set up Rnd: [K2, m1L, K1, P3, K9, P3]. Repeat to the end of the round. 6(7) sts increased. 114(133) total sts

PATTERN

Rnd 1: [K4, P3, K9, P3]. Repeat to the end of the round.

Rnd 2: repeat Rnd 1

Rnd 3: [K4, P3, 6-st RC, K3, P3]. Repeat to the end of the round.

Rnd 4: repeat Rnd 1

Rnd 5: repeat Rnd 1

Rnd 6: repeat Rnd 1

Rnd 7: [K4, P3, K3, 6-st LC, P3]. Repeat to the end of the round.

Rnd 8: repeat Rnd 1

Repeat rounds 1-8 until your hat measures 8.5" (9.5") from the folded brim edge or 11" (12") from the cast on edge.

Length is very customizable. So knit to the recommended length or until 1.25" fewer than your desired length.

CROWN

When your stitches become too few to work comfortably on Needle B, switch to Needle C

Rnd 1: [K4, P3, K9, P3].

Repeat to the end of the round. 114(133) total sts

Rnd 2: [K2, K2tog, P1, P2tog, K3, K2tog, K2, K2tog, P1,

P2tog]. Repeat to the end of the round. 30(35) sts decreased. 84(98) total sts

Rnd 3: [K3, P2, K7, P2].

Repeat to the end of the round.

Rnd 4: [K1, K2tog, P2, SSK, K1, K2tog, K2tog, P2].

Repeat to the end of the round.

24(28) sts decreased. 60(70) total sts

Rnd 5: [K2, P2, K4, P2].

Repeat to the end of the round.

Rnd 6: [K2tog, P2tog, SSK, K2tog, P2tog].

Repeat to the end of the round.

30(35) sts decreased. 30(35) total sts

Rnd 7: [SSK, K2tog, P1].

Repeat to the end of the round. 12(14) sts decreased. 18(21) total sts

Rnd 8: [K2tog, P1]. Repeat to the end of the round.

6(7) sts decreased. 12(14) total sts

Rnd 9: [SSK]. Repeat to the end of the round.

6(7) sts decreased. 6(7) total sts

FINISHING

Break yarn.

Thread tapestry needle and pull through the remaining stitches. Weave in ends.

Block hat.
