## WILLOUGHBY NESTING BINS PATTERN

## MATERIALS

2 colorways Echoview Fiber Mill Lanyard Yarn

Shown in Natural and Dove Grey (one cone in each colorway will make all three bins)

## TOOLS

Size N crochet hook
Large darning needle

## GAUGE

Rounds $1-6$ will be approximately 4-4.25" in diameter after blocking with a Size N crochet hook
*Don't get caught up on gauge for these - if you're happy with the fabric you've made, great! If it seems too loose or too tight, adjust accordingly.

## SIZE

Small (Medium, Jumbo) Small: 5" diameter, 4" tall Medium: 6.5" diameter, $5^{\prime \prime}$ tall Jumbo: 9.5" diameter, $7^{\prime \prime}$ tall


## CONSTRUCTION NOTES

These storage bins are quick to crochet and can easily be adapted to any size. You'll start with a flat base, crocheted in the round, and then work straight up the sides. I've outlined a small, medium, and jumbo size, but if you'd like to change it up, simply crochet the round base as outlined until your approximate diameter is met, and start working up the sides with the same general formula.

The eyelash stitch pattern almost resembles a woven basket, and results in a sturdy bin that could be used to hold fruit on your kitchen island, your
current WIP, or a treasured houseplant. If your basket feels a little wobbly at first, do not worry! A quick block and shaping will result in nice, even stitches.

## WILLOUGHBY NESTING BINS

*Please note: Color $A$ will always be the color you begin with. I alternated between sizes, starting with Natural for the Small and Jumbo, but Dove Grey for the Medium Size.

## BASE

1. Create a ring using the magic loop method, 6 sc in ring, $s$ st to join in the round.
2. Ch $1,2 \mathrm{sc}$ in same st, 2 sc in next 5 st , sl st to join. ( 12 sc ) 3. Ch $1,1 s c$ in same st, $2 s c$ in next st, [ 1 sc in next $s t, 2 s c$ in next st] 5x, sl st to join. (18 sc)
3. Ch $1,1 \mathrm{lsc}$ in same st, 1 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, [1sc in next 2 st, $2 s c$ in next st] $5 x$, sl st to join. (24)
4. Ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in same st, 1 sc in next $2 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, [1sc in next 3 st, 2 sc in next st] 5 x , sl st to join. ( 30 sc )
5. Ch $1,1 \mathrm{lsc}$ in same st, 1 sc in next 3 st, 2 sc in next st, [ 1 sc in next 4 st, 2 sc in next st] 5 x , sl st to join. ( 36 sc )

FOR SMALL SIZE, continue below to Round 13
7. Ch $1,1 s c$ in same st, 1 lc in next 4 st, 2 sc in next st, [1sc in next 5 st, $2 s c$ in next st] 5 x , sl st to join. ( 42 sc )
8. Ch $1,1 \mathrm{lsc}$ in same st, 1 sc in next $5 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, [1sc in next 6 st, 2 sc in next st] 5 x , sl st to join. ( 48 sc )

FOR MEDIUM SIZE, continue below to Round 13
9. Ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ in same st, 1 sc in next $6 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st , $[1 \mathrm{sc}$ in next 7 st, 2 sc in next st] 5 x , sl st to join. ( 54 sc ) 10. Ch 1, 1sc in same st, 1 lsc in next 7 st, 2 sc in next st, [1sc in next 8 st, 2 sc in next st] 5 x , sl st to join. ( 60 sc ) 11. Ch $1,1 \mathrm{lsc}$ in same st, 1 sc in next 8 st, 2 sc in next st, [1sc in next 9 st, 2 sc in next st] 5 x , sl st to join. ( 66 sc )
12. Ch $1,1 \mathrm{lsc}$ in same st, 1 sc in next $9 \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next $\mathrm{st},[1 \mathrm{sc}$ in next 10 st, 2 sc in next st] 5 x , sl st to join. (72 sc)

FOR JUMBO SIZE, continue below to Round 13
13. Ch 1, lsc in the back loop of the same st, lsc in next $35(47,71)$ st, sl st to join. $36(48,72)$ sc
14-16. Ch 1, 1sc in same st, lsc in next $35(47,71)$ st, sl st to join. $36(48,72)$ sc

## SIDES

Cut yarn, change to Color B, and work rounds 17-20
17. Ch 1, 1sc in same st, lsc in sc 1 row below next st, lsc in sc 2 rows below next st, lsc in sc 3 rows below next st, lsc in sc 2 rows below next st, lsc in sc 1 row below next st, [1sc in next st, 1sc in sc 1 row below next st, 1sc in sc 2 rows below next st, lsc in sc 3 rows below next st, lsc in sc 2 rows below next st, lsc in sc 1 row below next st] until no st remain, sl st to join. $36(48,72)$ sc
18-20. Ch 1, lsc in same st, lsc in next $35(47,71)$ sts, sl st to join. $36(48,72)$ sc

Cut yarn, change to Color A, work rounds 21-24
21. Ch 1 , lsc in sc 3 rows below same st, lsc in sc 2 rows below next st, 1sc in sc 1 row below next st, 1sc in next st, [1sc in sc 1 row below next st, lsc in sc 2 rows below next st, lsc in sc 3 rows below next st, lsc in sc 2 rows below next st, lsc in sc 1 row below next st, lsc in next st] until 2 stitches remain, lsc in sc 1 row below next st, lsc in sc 2 rows below next st, sl st to join. $36(48,72)$ sc
22-24. Ch l, sc in same st, sc in next $35(47,71)$ sts, sl st to join. $36(48,72)$ sc

Repeat Rounds 17-24 until you reach your preferred height, ending on Round 17 or Round 21. Fasten off and work in ends.
