Made with sustainable and sturdy Fancy Tiger Crafts Heirloom Romney yarn, it's hearty enough to be dragged around by little ones, or taken to the park for picnics and stargazing. The large throw has plenty of room for two to snuggle under. A lap size version is perfect for a baby blanket or a smaller throw. Whichever size you choose, the Heirloom Chevron Throw will stand the test of time, looking great for many years to come.

# HEIRLOOM CHEVRON THROW



## FINISHED SIZE

Sizes: 1 (2)  
Lap 35"x50" (Large Throw 52"x74")  
Sample shown in Large Throw size.

## MATERIALS

Fancy Tiger Crafts Heirloom  
Romney; 200 yds/4oz skein  
Color A: Pepper; 1 (2) skeins  
Color B: Blackberry; 1 (2) skeins  
Color C: Eggplant; 1 (2) skeins  
Color D: Radicchio; 1 (2) skeins  
Color E: Concord; 1 (2) skeins  
Color F: Medium Natural; 1 (2) skeins

## GAUGE

13 sts & 24 rows = 4"/10cm in  
garter stitch

## TOOLS

US 10 (6mm) circular needles,  
40"/100cm length  
Waste yarn, 2 stitch markers, and a  
tapestry needle.

## ABBREVIATIONS

BO: bind off

CO: cast on

dec: decrease(d)

inc: increase(d)

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 sts together

m: marker

m1L: with left needle tip, lift  
strand between needles from  
front to back. Knit lifted loop  
through back. (1 st inc)

m1R: with left needle tip, lift  
strand between needles from  
back to front. Knit lifted loop  
through front. (1 st inc)

pm: place marker

RS: right side of fabric

sl: slip (purlwise with yarn in back  
unless otherwise indicated)

slm: slip marker

ssk: slip 2 stitches knitwise one  
at a time, knit them together  
through back loop.(1 st dec)

st(s): stitch(es)

## PATTERN STITCHES AND NOTES

- Notes:
- Circular needles are used to accommodate a large number of stitches, the blanket is worked flat.
  - When counting rows in garter stitch, each "ridge" of stitches is 2 rows. A count of 5 ridges equals 10 rows.

### G-INC (Garter Increase Stitch):

Row 1: K1, m1L, k to m, m1L, slm, k1, slm, m1R, k to last st, m1R, k1.

Row 2: K to end.

### G-CHEV (Garter Chevron Stitch):

Row 1: K1, ssk, k to m, m1L, slm, k1, slm, m1R, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Row 2: K to end.

### G-DEC (Garter Decrease Stitch):

Row 1: K1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1.

Row 2: K to end.

## CAST ON

With Color A, using longtail cast on, CO 3 (3) sts.

## SET-UP ROWS

**Set-up Row 1:** K1, m1L, pm, k1, pm, m1R, k1. *5 sts*

**Set-up Row 2:** K to end.

## BLANKET

Work in G-INC st for 70 (106) rows. *145 (217) sts*

Change to Color B. Work in G-CHEV st for 34 (50) rows.

Change to Color C. Work in G-CHEV st for 34 (50) rows.

Change to Color D. Work in G-CHEV st

## PATTERN

for 34 (50) rows.

Change to Color E. Work in G-CHEV st for 34 (50) rows.

## FINAL BLANKET SECTION

Change to Color F.

**Set-up Row 1:** K1, ssk, k to 3 sts before m, k2tog, k1, remove marker, k1. Place rem 72 (108) sts on waste yarn. *71 (107) sts*

**Set-up Row 2:** BO 1, k to end. *70 (106) sts*

Work in G-DEC st for 66 (102) rows. *4 sts*

**Row 1:** Ssk, k2tog. *2 sts*

**Row 2:** K2.

**Row 3:** Ssk. *1 st*

Break yarn and tie off.

Continuing in Color F, place 72 (108) sts from waste yarn onto needle. With RS facing, join yarn and work as follows.

Work in G-DEC st for 68 (104) rows. *4 sts*

**Row 1:** Ssk, k2tog. *2 sts*

**Row 2:** K2.

**Row 3:** Ssk. *1 st*

Break yarn and tie off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Hand wash vigorously in cold water and gentle detergent. Roll in towel to remove excess water. Lay flat to dry, and then enjoy your gorgeous new throw!
