

# MAPLE SEED HAT DORIAN OWEN 

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The Maple Seed Hat is a DK weight crocheted hat designed for the 2022 Yarn Along the Rockies Yarn Crawl. It comes with three sizes and two color options: single color, or two color.
This design uses the spike stitch to create fun texture and movement throughout.

## MAPLE SEED HAT

## SIZES

S (M, L), 18" (21", 24")
circumference, unstretched

## MATERIALS

1 skein Birch Hollow Fiber's Phillis DK (250yds/115g)

## TOOLS

4.5 mm crochet hook
locking stitch marker
tapestry needle for weaving in ends

## GAUGE

14 rounds in pattern $=4^{\prime \prime}, 16 \mathrm{dc}=4^{\prime \prime}$

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS
S (M, L), 18" (21", 24")
circumference, unstretched

## NOTES

- Hat is worked top down with the Right Side (RS) facing you.

Do not turn after each round

- It is not recommended to use the Magic Loop method to create the beginning ring
- Beginning chains of each round do not count as stitches
- Stitch counts are given in italics at the end of each round.

Be sure your stitch counts are correct

- In the crown, do NOT skip the stitches behind the Spike stitches as this creates the increases
- In the body and brim, DO skip the stitch behind the Spike stitches
- Take care to not make the Spike stitches too tight as it may pucker the crochet fabric
- This pattern also works up well in 2 colors; use Color A for the odd numbered (dc stitch) rounds and Color B for the even numbered (SPsc stitch) rounds.


## ABBREVIATIONS

Use color B for both rounds of the brim

## ch - chain

slst - slip stitch
dc - double crochet
sc - single crochet
st/sts - stitch/stitches
Spike stitch (SPsc) - insert
hook into indicated stitch 2
rounds below, pull up a loop
to height of current round,
yarn over and pull through
2 loops


## Pattern

## Crown

DO NOT skip stitches behind the SPsc
Ch3, slst into first ch to join and form a ring
Round 1 - ch2 (does not count as a stitch here and throughout), 7 dc into ring, slst to first dc to join. $6(7,8) \mathrm{dc}$

Round 2 - chl, sc in first dc, SPsc into ring, *sc into st behind SPsc, SPsc into ring, repeat from * around, slst in first sc to join.
$6(7,8)$ sc, $6(7,8)$ SPsc
Round 3 - ch2, 2dc in first st, $d c$ in next st, *2dc in next st, dc in next st, repeat from * around, slst in first dc to join. $18(21,24) d c$

Round 4 - chl, *sc in 3 dc , SPsc in SPsc 2 rounds directly below, repeat from * around, slst in first sc to join, place marker in last SPsc of round. $18(21,24)$ sc, $6(7,8)$ SPsc

Round 5 - ch2, 2dc in first st, dc in next 3 sts, * $2 d c$ in next st, dc in next 3 sts, repeat from * around, slst in first dc to join, do not move marker. $30(35,40)$ dc

Round 6 - chl, sc in first dc, SPsc in the marked SPsc 2 rounds below and 2 sts behind current position, sc in 2 dc, *SPsc in SPsc 2 rounds below and 2 sts in front of current position, sc in 3 dc , SPsc in the same stitch as last SPsc, sc in 2 dc , repeat from * around to last 2 dc , SPsc in marked SPsc 2 rounds below and 2 sts in front of current position, sc in 2 dc , slst in first sc to join, remove marker. $30(35,40)$ sc, $12(14,16)$ SPsc

Round 7 - ch2, 2dc in first st, dc in next 6 sts, *2dc in next st, dc in next 6 sts, repeat from ${ }^{*}$ around, slst in first dc to join. $48(56,64) d c$

Round 8 - chl, *sc in 2 dc , SPsc in SPsc 2 rounds directly below, sc in 2 dc, repeat from ${ }^{*}$ around, slst in first sc to join. $48(56,64)$ sc, $12(14,16)$ SPsc

Round 9 - ch2, dc in each st around. $60(70,80) d c$
Round 10 - chl, *sc in 3 dc , SPsc in SPsc 2 rounds directly below, sc in 2 dc , repeat from * around, slst in first sc to join, place marker in first SPsc of round. $60(70,80)$ sc, $12(14,16)$ SPsc

## Body <br> DO skip stitches behind the SPsc

Round 11 - ch2, dc in each st around, do not move marker.
$72(84,96) d c$
Round 12 - chl, *sc, SPsc in marked SPsc 2 rounds below and 3 stitches in front of current position, sc in $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{SPsc}$ in same SPsc as last SPsc, repeat from * around, slst in first sc to join, move marker up to first SPsc of round. $48(56,64)$ sc, $24(28,32)$ SPsc


Round 13 - Repeat Round 11 .
Round 14 - chl, sc in 3 dc , SPsc in the marked SPsc 2 rounds below and 2 stitches behind current position, ${ }^{*}$ sc, skip SPsc, SPsc in SPsc 2 rounds below and 3 stitches in front of current position, sc in 3 dc , SPsc in same SPsc as last SPsc, repeat from * around to last 2 dc , sc, SPsc in marked SPsc, slst in first dc to join, move marker up to first SPsc of round. $48(56,64)$ sc, $24(28,32)$ SPsc

Round 15 - Repeat Round 11 .
Round 16 - chl, sc, SPsc in SPsc 2 rounds below and 3 stitches in front of current position, sc in $3 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{SPsc}$ in same SPsc as last, *sc, skip SPsc directly below, SPsc in SPsc 2 rounds below and 3 stitches in front of current position, sc in 3 dc, SPsc in same SPsc as last repeat from * around, slst in first sc to join, move marker up to first SPsc of round. $48(56,64)$ sc, $24(28,32)$ SPsc

Round 17 - Repeat round 11.
Repeat rounds 14-17 until hat is desired length.
End hat body on an odd numbered round.

## Brim

DO skip stitches behind the SPsc
Brim Round l-chl, sc in first dc, SPsc in next st 2 rounds directly below, *sc in next dc, SPsc in next st 2 rounds directly below, repeat from * around, slst in first sc to join.
$36(42,48)$ sc, $36(42,48)$ SPsc
Brim Round 2 - chl, sc in first st and each st around,
slst in first sc to join. $72(84,96)$ sc
Cut yarn, weave in ends, and enjoy!
Have extra yarn leftover? Make a pom pom to add to the top of the hat!
