Boobook Owl

The Boobook is Australia's smallest owl, and like all nocturnal birds, it sleeps in the day and comes out to feed at night.

It has dark brown feathers with spots of white and grey and has yellow eyes. Its favourite foods are mice, small birds and insects, such as moths and beetles.

It is called a boobook owl because it makes a "boo book" call which can be heard in deserts, rainforests and in city suburbs all around Australia.

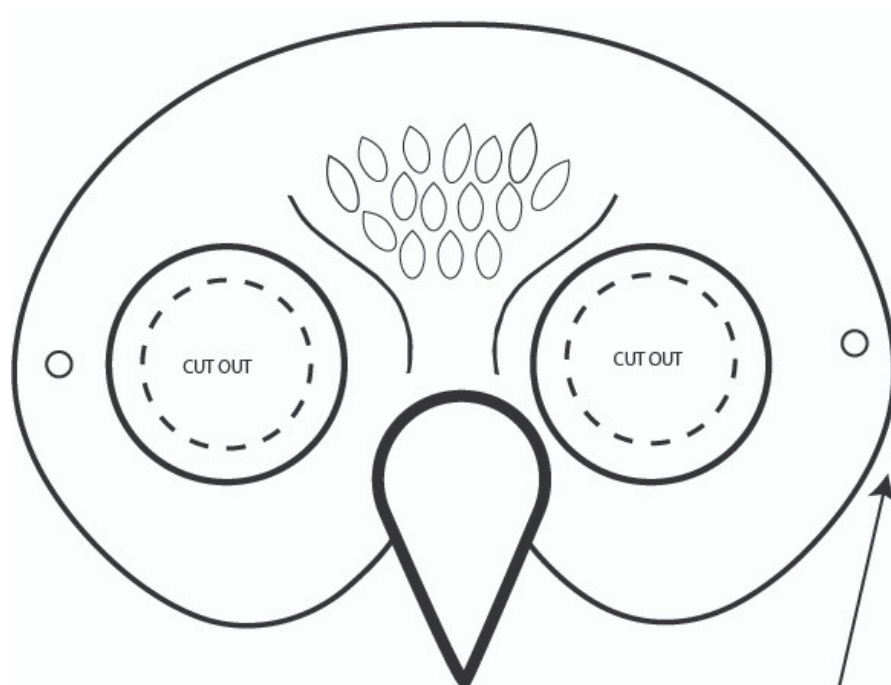

4. Glue, staple or sticky tape your nature finds onto the mask. Get Creative & have fun.

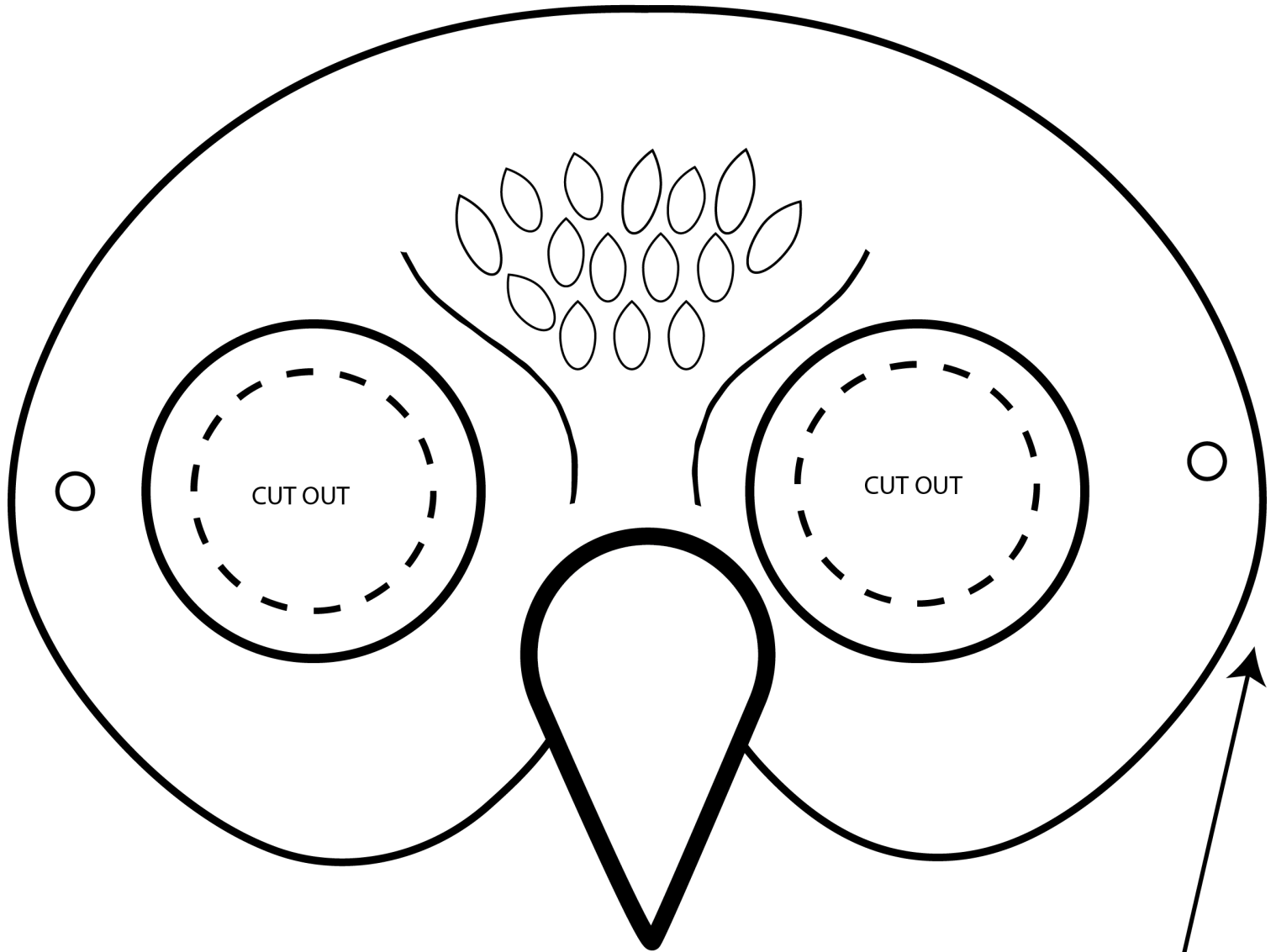
3. Cut out your mask and poke some holes to tie string through.
