

Assembly Instructions for **BRISTOW 2-SEATER FUTON**

Design may vary but
basic assembly is the same

SAFETY WARNINGS

1. Before attempting to assemble or install this product read and follow the instructions in leaflet and on any attached labels!
2. **NEVER ALLOW CHILDREN TO PLAY WITH OR OPERATE THE FOLD OUT BED ACTION AND BEWARE OF THE DANGERS WITH MOVING PARTS WHICH CAN CAUSE ENTRAPMENT.**
3. **Routine Maintenance:**
Periodically check that all fixture and connectors are tight.
4. Do not stand hot products directly on the wood surface.
5. Mop up any spills immediately.
6. Surface of wood is not resistant to bleaches, acids, or other "aggressive" agents.
7. Never use substitute parts. Always contact the supplier for replacement parts:



Use 2 people and assemble unit close to its final position.





To avoid scratching, we advise that assembly takes place on a protected surface.

Do not discard any of the packaging, until you have checked all the parts and fittings.











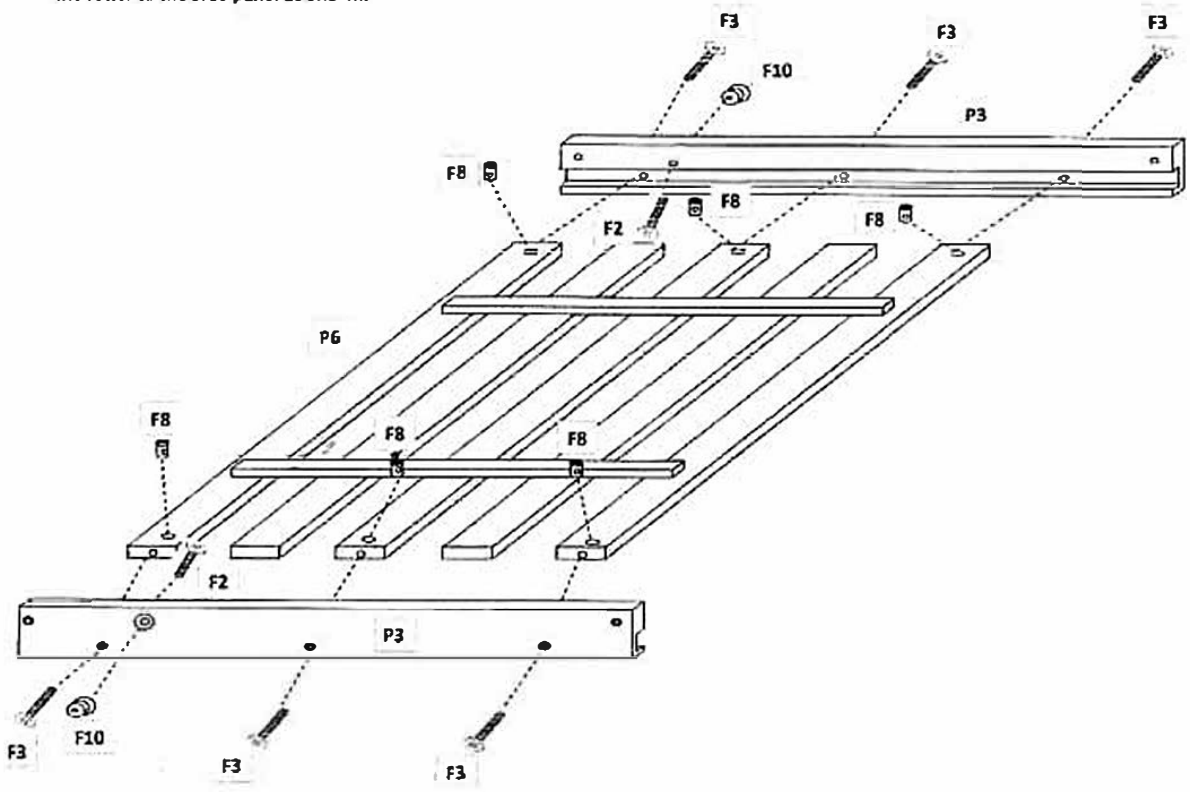
Step 1

Assemble Side Panel to Front Deck



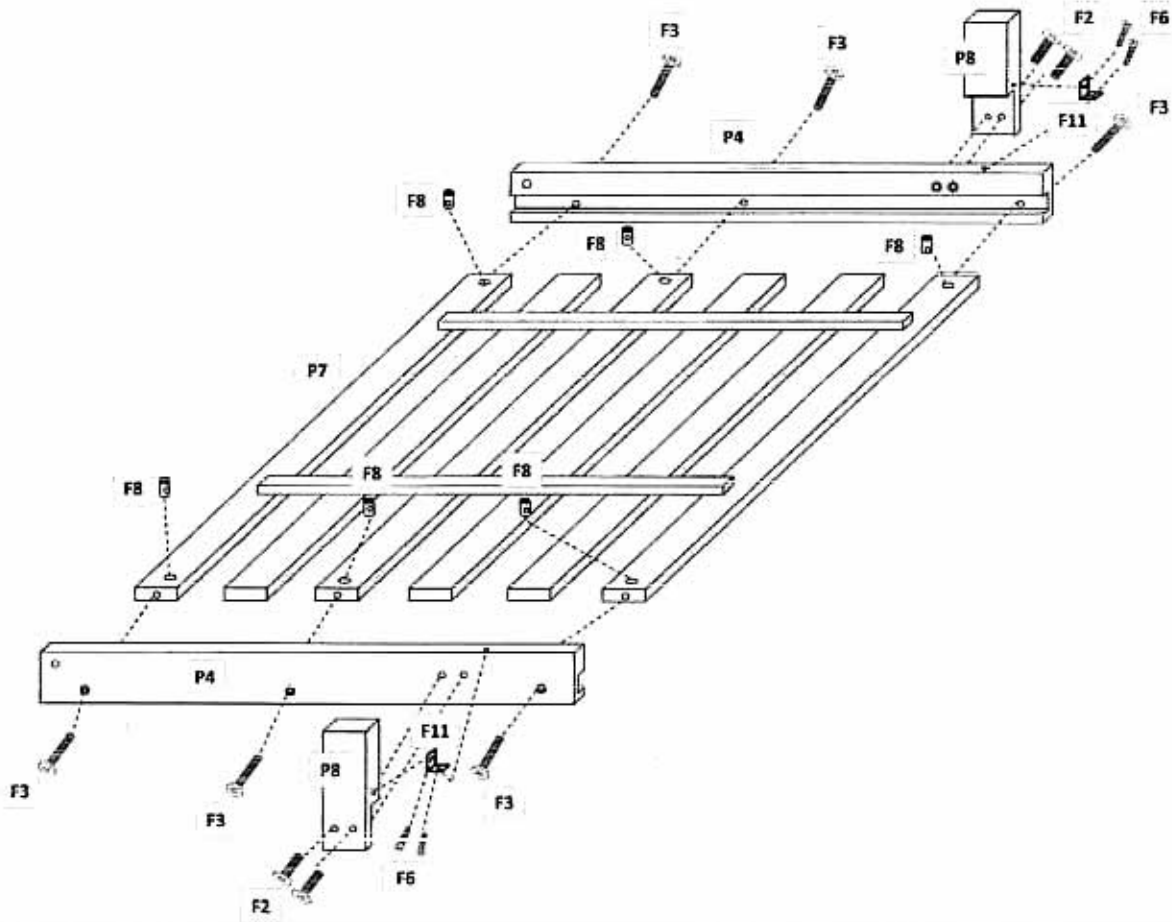
Step 2

Assemble Side Panel to Middle Deck and attach the roller to the side panel as shown.



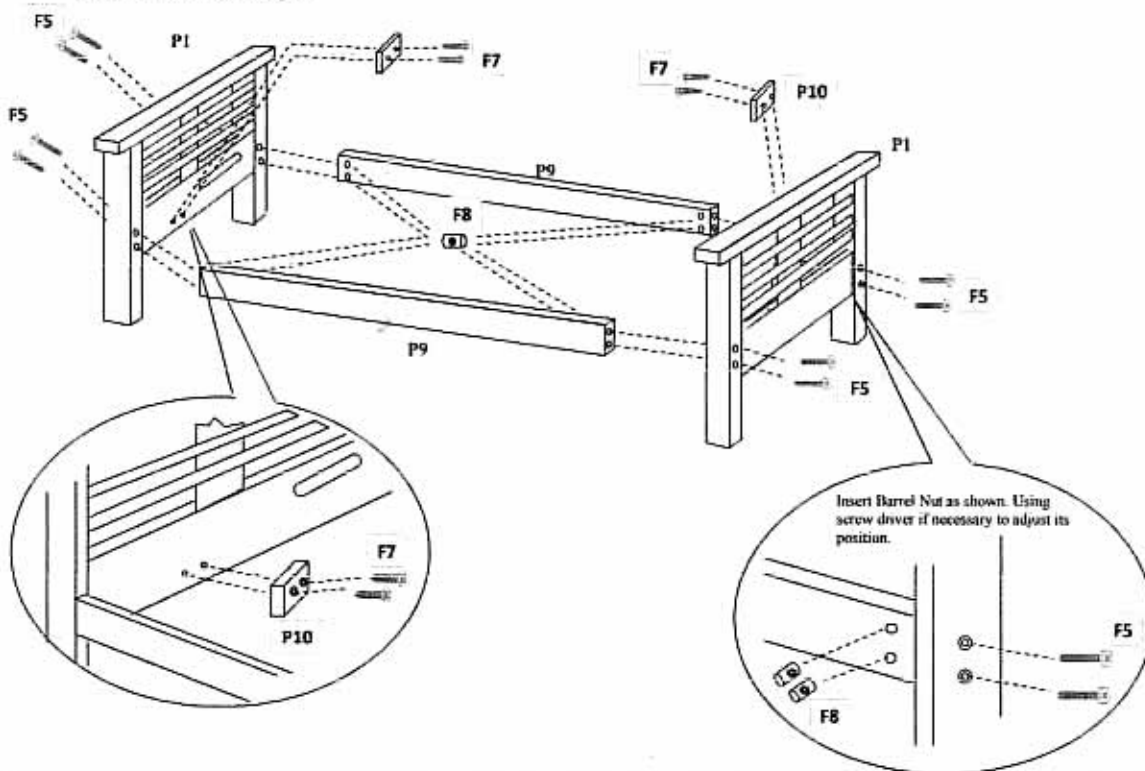
Step 3

Assemble Side Panel to Rear Deck.



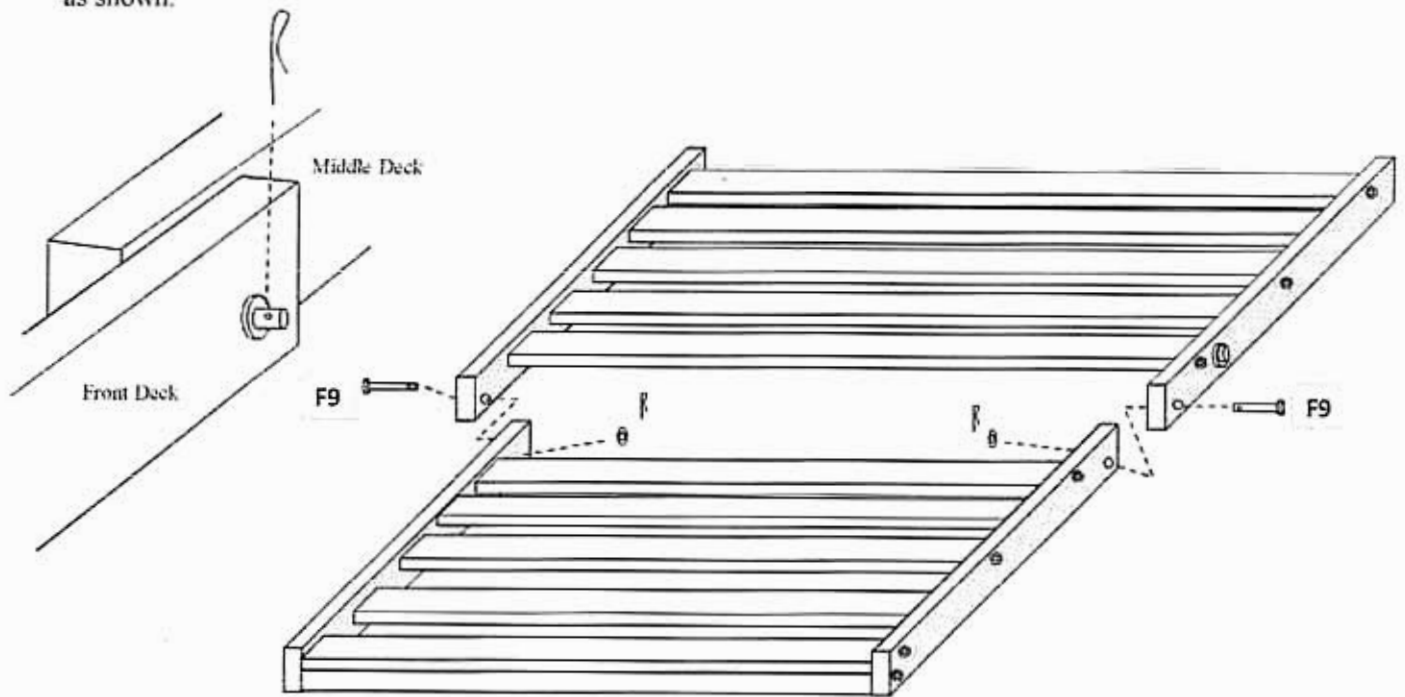
Step 4

Assemble stretcher rails to the Arm and screw the deck support as shown.
Do not tighten the bolts yet.



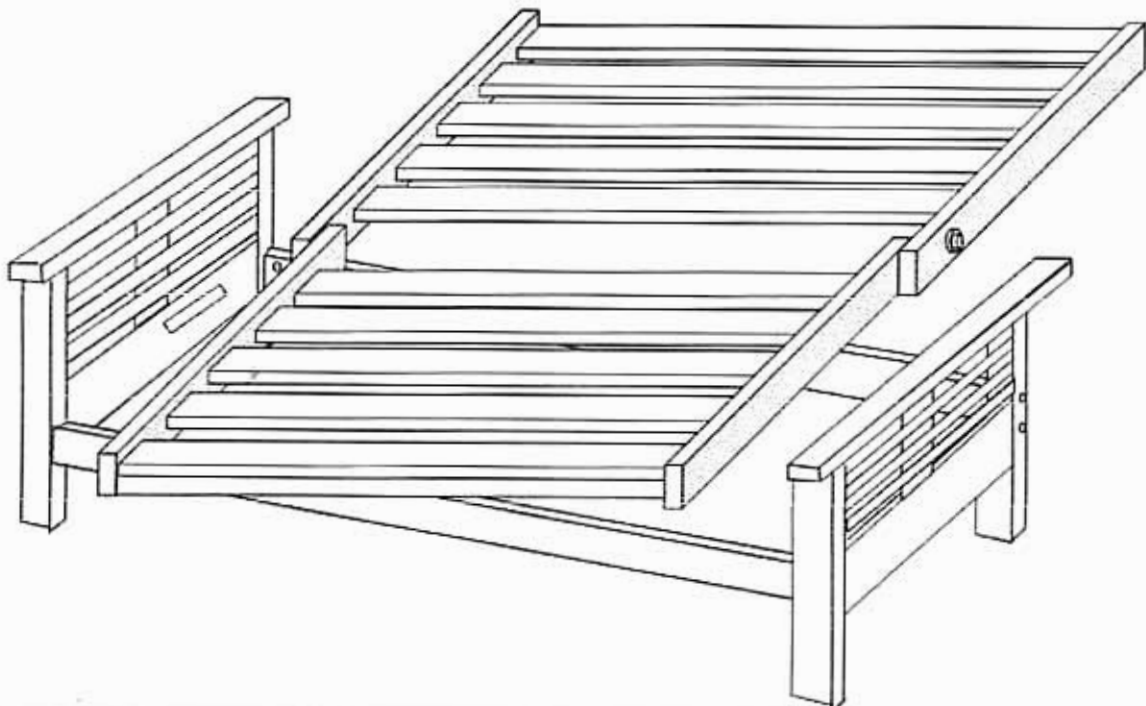
Step 5

Join the front deck with the middle deck with the clevis pin as shown below. Insert the clevis pin and spring clip as shown.



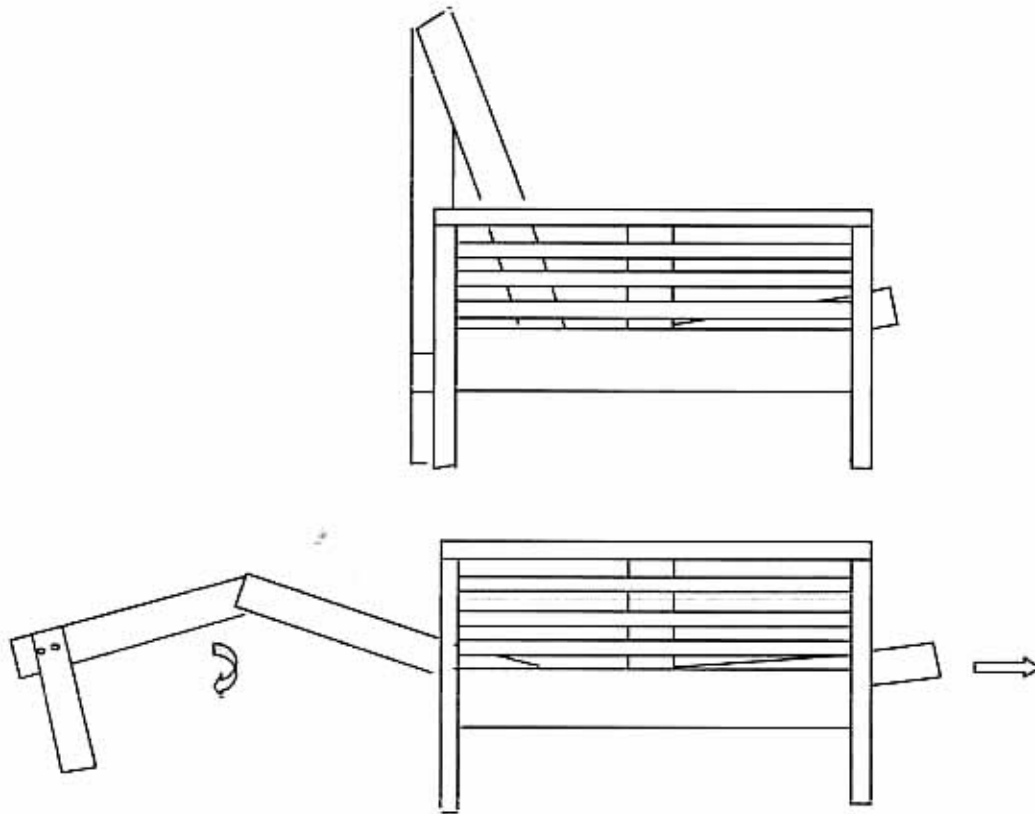
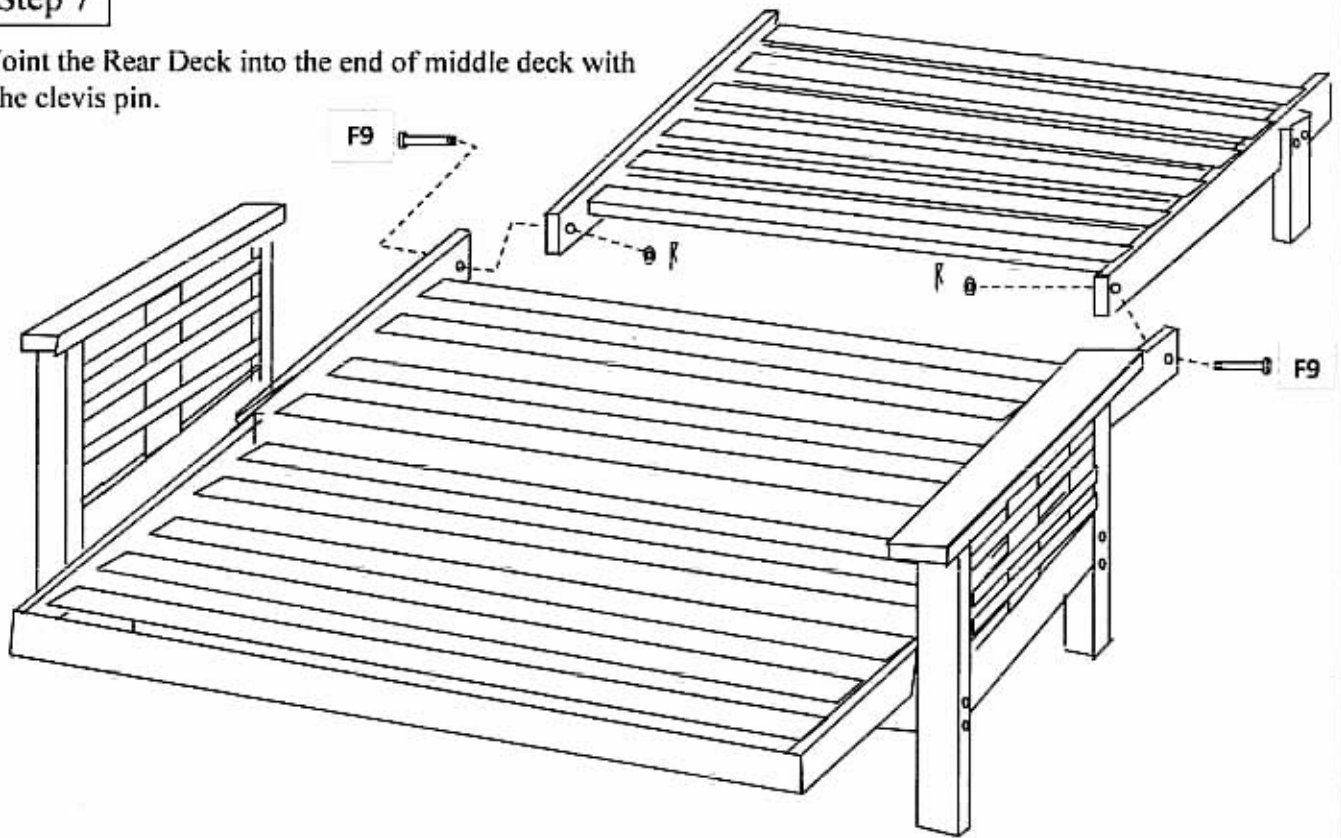
Step 6

Insert the deck assembled in STEP 5 orientated flat. Insert one side with the roller slotted into the groove found in the Arm. Then, gently lower the other end. Once decks are in place, tighten all the bolts.



Step 7

Joint the Rear Deck into the end of middle deck with the clevis pin.



To convert into bed: Pull the rear deck gently down and then pull the front deck forward until it stops.
To convert back to lounge position, push the front deck inward and then lift the middle deck upward and push the rear deck toward the back of the arm.
