## **CLEAN REGULARLY:**

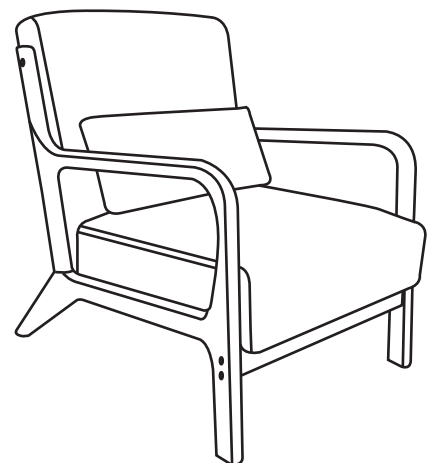
- ✚ Remove dust by pre-brushing with a soft brush
- ✚ Gently Vacuum all areas

## **SUNLIGHT AND HEAT**

- ✚ Direct sunlight or heat can cause fabrics to deteriorate or fade. Protect them by situating your furniture out of the way of prolonged direct sunlight or by drawing curtains and blinds when applicable.
- ✚ Avoid placing furniture too close to fires or radiators.
- ✚ Reduce potential damage by moving items around or changing position so that the same piece or area is not always exposed.









## **SAFETY WARNINGS**

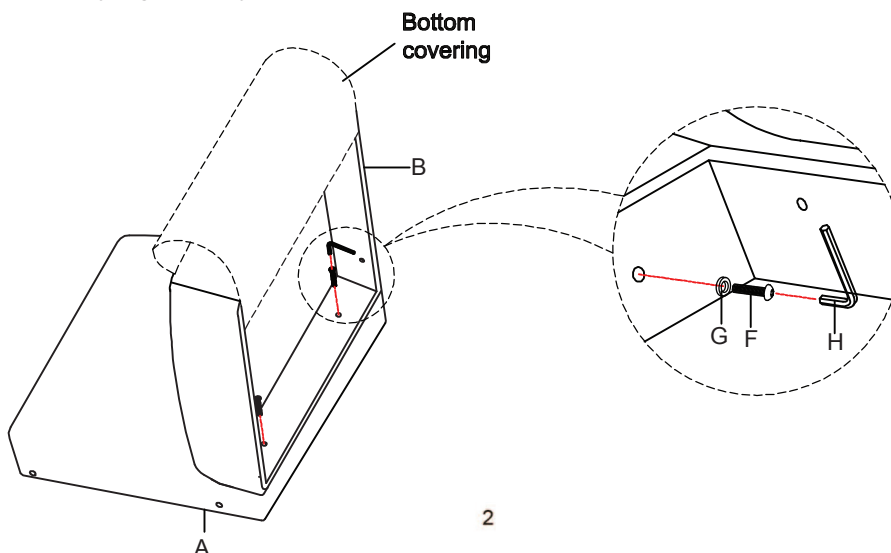

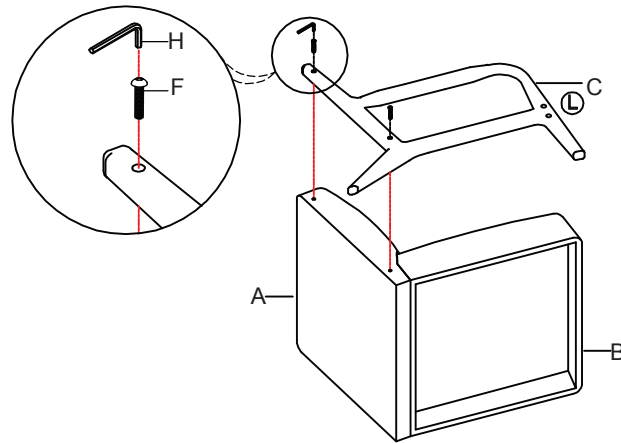
2 Person Assembly

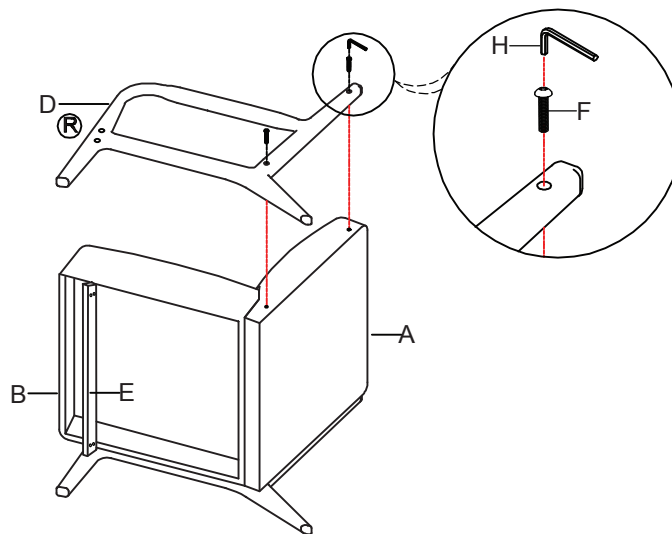
Step 1. Assemble the lounge on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish. Open the bottom covering, then loosely attach seat cushion (B) to back cushion (A) using bolts ( F ), lock big flat washers (G). Loosely tight ten by Allen wrench (H).



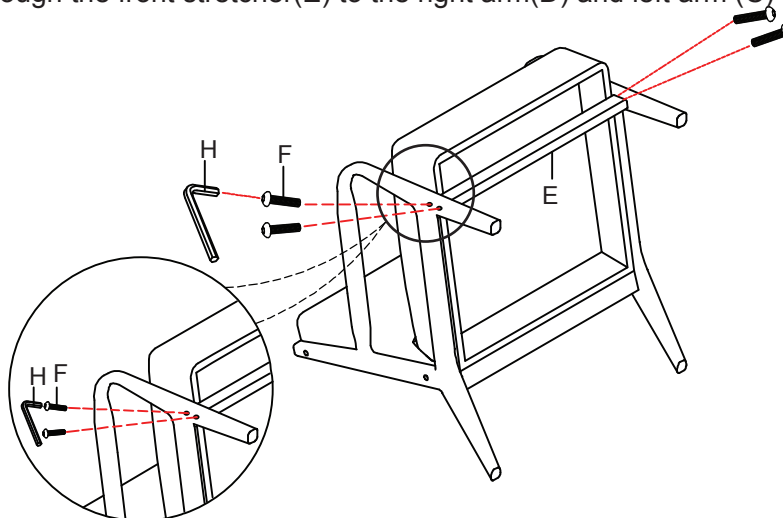
Step 2. Attach left arm (C) to seat cushion (B) and back cushion (A) using bolts (F), lock flat washers (G) according to the label "L" on the left arm (C) and the side of seat cushion (B) and back cushion (A). Loosely tighten by Allen wrench (H) as shown below.



Step 3. Insert front stretcher (E) to left arm (C) with two located dowels. Note: the front stretcher (E) with screw holes should be face down. Attach right arm (D) to the front stretcher (E), seat cushion (B) and back cushion (A) using bolts (F), lock flat washers (G) according to the label R on the right arm (D) and the side of seat cushion (B) and back cushion (A). Securely tighten all bolts by Allen wrench (H).



Step 4. Tighten Bolts (F) through the front stretcher (E) to the right arm (D) and left arm (C) with Allen wrench (H).
